



### **NELLE'S** NEWS

People are busy baking during the holiday season. One question often asked pertains to the use of baking powder. Baking soda and baking powder both act as leavenings in quick breads--but can't be used interchangeably.

Baking soda reacts with an acid such as vinegar or sour milk to form carbon dioxide. When soda is used as a leavening agent, it must be sifted with the dry ingredients so that the carbon dioxide, when soda is used as a leavening agent, it must be sifted with the dry ingredients so that the carbon dioxide is released in the batter and dough during mixing and baking.

Because sour milk varies in acidity, cream of tartar is joften added to react with the soda. Two and a half teaspoons of cream of tartar react with one teaspoon of soda.

Baking powder is a mixture of baking, soda and a dry acid or reacting salt.

Baking powder are classified as "quick acting" (tactrate) which releases the largest amount of carbon dioxide when the mixture is cold, "Double-acting" baking powder is recommended when the food must stand for a while before baking.

One sure cure for the wintertime blues is to brighten your surroundings with some beautiful plants. They are excellent for Christmas gifts and help to give fresh meaning to the Christmas message.

Numerous plants are available in supermarkets, variety stores, garden centers, florist and specialty shops. Keep in mind when you are selecting plants, that several of the ones associated with Christmas are poisonous. Dieffenbachia, mistletoe, star of Bethlehem, and hyacinth bulbs are only a few of the more than 700 species of plants that are known to

Bethlehem, and hyacinth bulbs are only a few of the more than 700 species of plants that are known to have caused illness or death. You probably have a plant or two that you might take a cutting from-airplane or snake plants, for example. Or begin some after-dinner gardening by recycling parts of some fruits and vegetables. Pineapple tops and avocado seeds grow into attractive houseplants fairly quickly. Yams when started in water yield lovely trailing vines. Grapefruit and orange seeds eventually turn into small trees.

If plants are on your Christmas list this year, you will want to give some thought to what to plant them in. The possibilities are as great as your imagination. Look around the house-are there any empty cans, mismatched glasses

or old jars? Is the plant in a clay pot? It's one of the best for the health of the plant, but not always the

best for the health of the plant, but not always the most attractive accessory. If it is already potted, you'll want to give it some yule-tide spirit.

Coffee cans, mixed nut cans, and shortening cans are good sizes for most small houseplants. They can be spra painted in no time at all. Paint is toxic for plants so be sure not to get any inside. Add wooden drawer pulls or spools for feet and handles to the side. Or wrap the can with medium thick rope for a natural look. A low wide can can become a hanging basket when macrame straps or leather thongs or shoclaces are attached. Punch holes in the bottom to allow excess moisture to drain into a saucer or into a second pot (Called double porting).

Glass jars, odd glasses and

Glass jars, odd glasses and empty borties can be attractive containers for vine type plants. They can be coated with patching plaster to change their original look or they can be spray painted. A brandy snifter with a bright ribbon makes a delightful container for a small plant or terrarium.

Clay pots can be spruced up with cut-outs from Christmas cards or decals and some decorative braid. Clay pots can also be painted but this does cut down on their porosity and the paint may flake off due to moisture.

# The Night that Christ was born...

The brightest star of all shown above Bethlehem that night. Three wise men, kings from afar, had followed the star for countless miles, their search ending when its bright light fell upon a simple stable.

Shepherds tending their sheep in the fields nearby also found their way to the stable. A messenger had appeared, saying that a king would be born in humble surroundings this night.

They had followed the star because they believed it would lead them to the Messiah. The shepherds were told to go to the stable to pay homage to the newborn king of kings.

This was the first Christmas. The birth of Christ. Here began that One Great Life upon earth, a life of dedication, service, and lasting testimony to God's love for all mankind.

Through long centuries and changing civilizations, the meaning of Christmas is constant. There can be no more universal holiday, no greater hope for now and hereafter than that which lies in the heritage of Christmas.

It is a little known fact, but the simple act of using jumper cable to start (boost) a car with a dead battery can lead to severe personal injury. It's true!

A good Samaritan in California was helping his neighbor start his car by jumping the battery. The battery exploded and our hero got a face full of sulfuric acid for his trouble.

A man in Pennsylvania noticed another charging his battery incorrectly. When he attempted to rearrange there was some sparking, and the battery exploded.

The reason for both of these accidents, and many others, is the fact that a battery being charged produces hydrogen gas, a very combustible and explosive element. The longer a battery is charged the greater the accumulation of hydrogen, and the greater the danger of a serious explosion. All that is required is a single spark as one connects either of the jumper cables to a battery post.

How does one avoid such an occurrence? Simple. Just follow the step-by-step procedure given below whenever you need to jump one battery to another.

Insure that the ignition switch and all electric accessories, including the lights, are turned off if both cars.

Verify that both batteries are rated for the same voltage. More automotive type batteries are 12-volt models these days; but many older cars, as well as some of the smaller models may have a 6-volt battery.

Remove the dustcaps from each cell of both batteries, and make certain that the electrolyte reaches the FULL mark. If not, ordinary tap water can be used to top-

off each ceil if distilled water is not available. If the dead battery is to be techarged, the dust-caps should be left off to prevent any buildup of pressure due to the rapid release of hydrogen gas from the battery fluid. Cover the battery opening to prevent any splashing acid from reaching your skin or clothing. Your handkerchief will suffice. Attach only one jumper cable at a time. Connect one end of the RED jumper cable at a time. Connect one end of the positive terminal of the good battery first. This is the terminal marked with a \*, a P, or POS. Then connect the other end to the positive terminal of the dead battery. Connect one end of the BLACK jumper cable to the negative terminal of the dead battery. This is the terminal marked with a \*, an N, or NEG. Then connect the other end to a point on the frame of the car with the dead battery at least 18 inches from the battery. Start the engine of the car with the good battery, Allow the car to warm up for a few minutes, holding engine speed to a fast idle. Start the engine of the car with the dead battery. If the engine starts, proceed to Step 9. If it doesn't, tum off the ignition and wair several minutes. Don't flood the engine with too much gasoline. If the battery is completely dead, wair about half an hour so the battery may be charged by the nunning car. Try to start the dead car again. Now, if successful, proceed to Step 9. If the car cannot be started, see a mechanic. Disconnect the jumper cables by reversing the order in which they were connected. Keep the car with the bad battery may be charged by the nunning car. The Texas Highway Patrol investigated three accidents on rural highways in Hansford County during the month of December, 1975, according to Sergeant C. E. Henderson, Highway Patrol supervisor of this area.

These crashes resulted in no persons killed and three persons injured.

The rural traffic accident summary for this county during the first 11 months of 1975 shows a total of 40 accident resulting in no persons killed and 25 persons injured.

The rural traffic accident summary for the 60 counties of the Lubbock Department of Public Safety Region for November, 1975, shows a total of 530 accidents resulting in 14 persons killed and 258 persons injured, as compared to November, 1974, with 497 accidents resulting in 10 persons killed and 229 persons injured. This was 33 more accidents, four more killed, and 29 more injured in 1975 at the same period of time.

The traffic deaths for the month of November, 1975, occurred in the following counties: Two cach in Swisher and Wilbarger; and one each in Clay, Crosby, Lubbock, Montague, Palo Pinto, Parker, Wichita, Hutchinson, Oldham, and Wheeler.




