pools. "Swimming and water sports are
beneficial to good health orovided one's physical condition justifies this type of exercse." Dr Cox asserted
"neverthletss, they possess danger ety, through carelessness or thought lessness, are disregarded." The State Health Officer outlined the following simple rules for bath ing and swimmng in safety: whe
swimming, be alert and careful unknown depths and currents; a least one hour should elapse after meal before entering the water; upon the first indication of fatigue, com
ashore and call it a day; if you be come chilled. leaye the water immediately; do not enter the water when overheated; learn to flozt, this is most important; never attempt to
rock a boat in a spirit of fun; neve swim in water that may be polluted. Swimming close to or even a few miles below a sewage outlets is inviting the possibility of acquiring
disease. "Excursions, picnics, and swimm
ing parties contribute to a healthy happy, normal life, which is always desirable," Dr. Cox said. "It is by no means advisable to iliminate these
excursions from our summer program, but it is important that they prove beneficial and not disastrous."
