PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO BE VOTED ON AT AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 7, 1965.
 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 44 proposing an amendment to Sections 2 and Article III of the Constitution of the State of Texas so as to provide for an increase in membership of the State Senate from 31 to 39 members; to increase the membership in the House of Representatives from 39 to 47 members; to require apportionment of the Senate according to population; and to provide for the limitation that no county is entitled to more than one Senator.
 IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 Section 1. That Sections 2 and 25 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Texas be amended to read respectively as follows:
 Section 2. The Senate shall consist of 39 members. The members of the Senate shall be elected by the people of the State at large.
 Section 25. The state shall be divided into Senatorial Districts of contiguous territory according to population, as nearly as possible.
 Should the Legislature enact enabling legislation in violation of this Amendment, no such law shall be valid by reason of its anticipation.

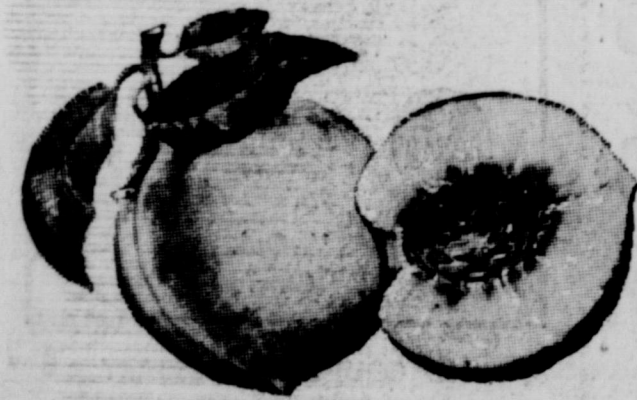
