WASHINGTON (AP) — President Truman may drop out of the presidential campaign for a while after he and Gov. Adlai E. Stevenson of Illinois share Labor Day's political stage.

Superforts Blast Korean Grenade Plant

SEOUL, Korea (AP) — Fourteen Japan-based U. S. Superforts last night bombed a huge Communist grenade factory employing 2,000 workers in Northwest Korea. The factory was only 3 miles south of the Manchurian border.

Far East headquarters in Tokyo said the sprawling works was one of the 78 military targets the U. N. Command has given advance notice it will attack.

It was the first time the plant, at Nakhon, half way between Snuju and Namsong, had been hit.

Results of the raid were not announced. The planes dropped 140 tons of bombs.

But the B29 pilots, skirting the edge of an erratic typhoon sweeping across the southern end of the Korean Peninsula, reported they met intense anti-aircraft fire.

The report, which may have diplomatic repercussions abroad, promptly became fuel for a federal grand jury which will open next month an investigation of alleged price fixing and monopoly practices in the oil industry.

Wedding Bell For Amputee

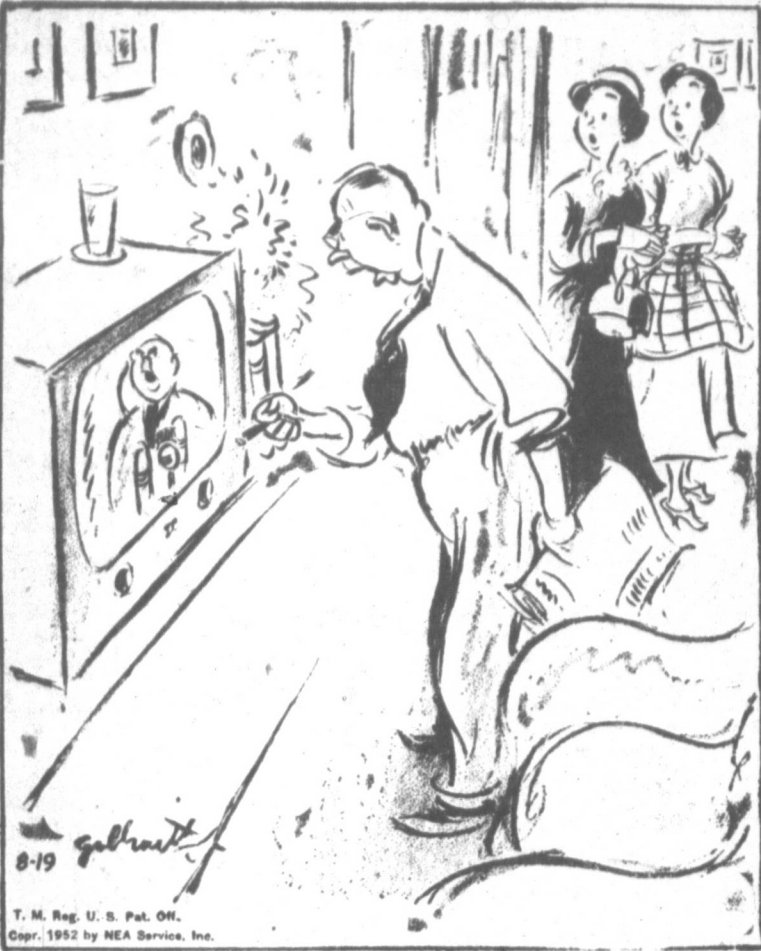

As a plain deaf girl in "Johnny Belinda," she won one of those gold things the academy hands out annually. Last year she snagged her third Oscar nomination with "The Blue Veil," which was strictly a four-handkerchief epic. "But audiences don't want to see pictures like those right now," she protested as we lolled beside her pale blue swimming pool. Some-tolling! "They have enough troubles of their own, without go-

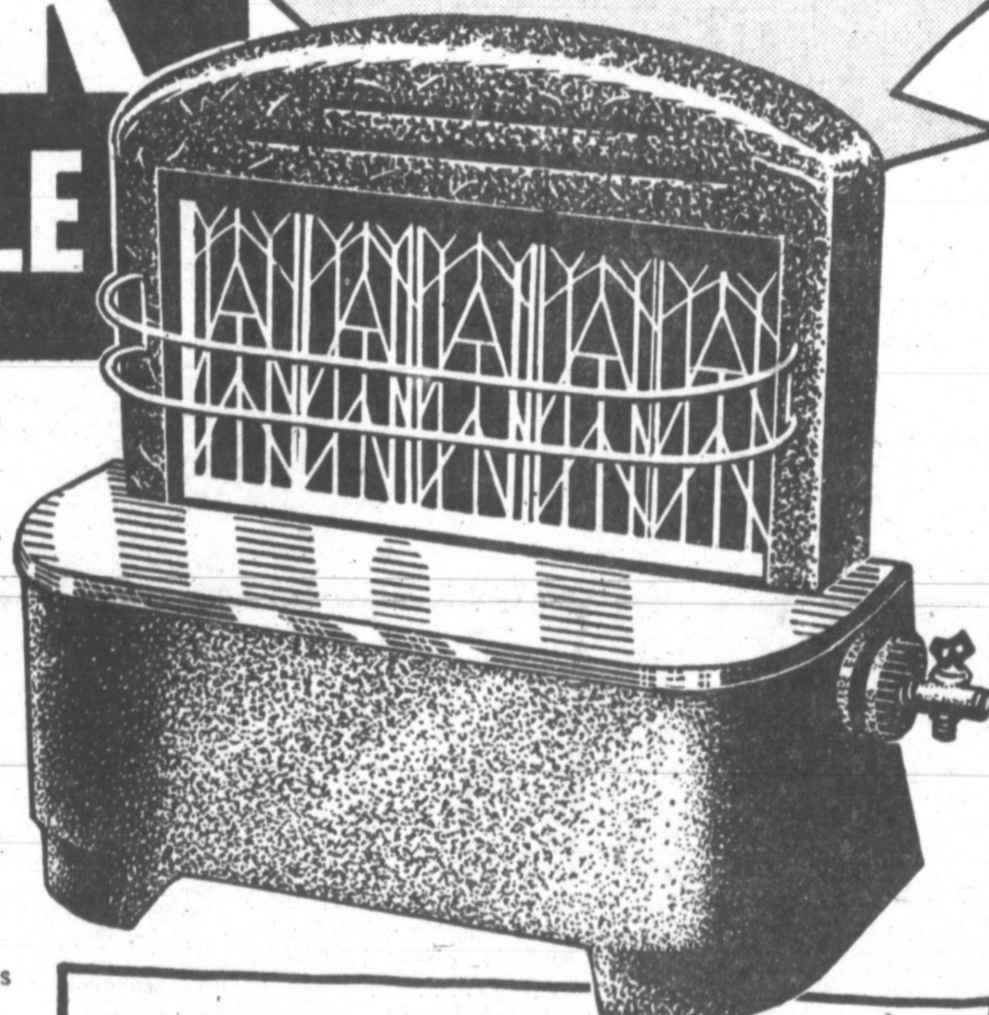
ing to see more problems on the screen. That's why I want to sing and laugh in the movies I make."

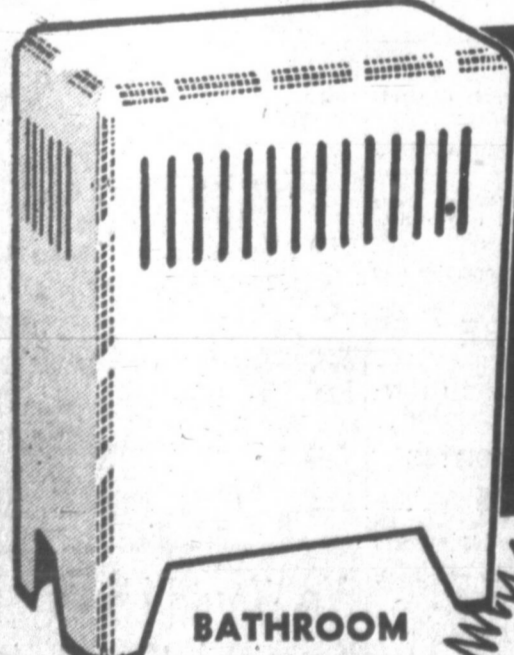

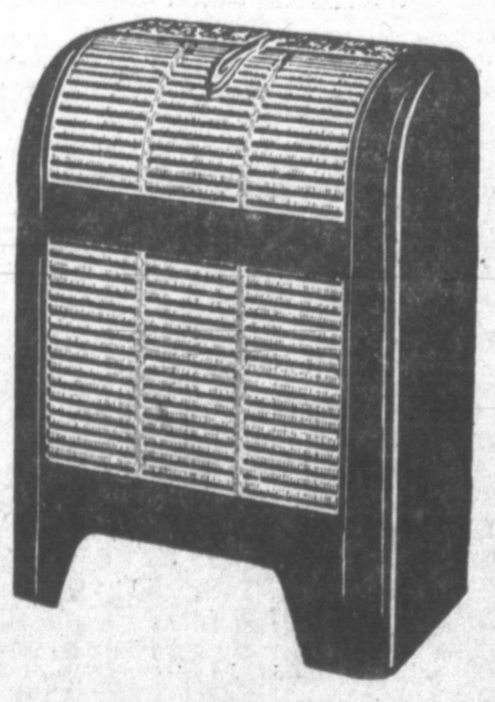
