

HELENA, Ark., Oct. 3 .- Developments today show that race trou bles in the southern part of this county are due largely to propaganda spread among the ignorant negroes by designing white men and a negro said to reside at Winchester, Crew county.

The negroes were told that the government was to buy cotton and they must demand their share. Social equality also is said to have been part of the propaganda.

SPUDDING NEW WELL AT ROWENA

All hopes of clearing the fifteen hundred foot hole of the Runnels County Oil Co. in its well near Rowena have been abandoned. W. A. Halamicek, manager of the company, was here Thursday, and stated that work of skidding the derrick was under way, and as soon as the derrick could be moved over about twenty feet a new well would be spudded in.

This comes as a piece of hard luck for the Runnels County Oil Co., who have suffered much loss of time and money in trying to fish tools from the present well.

A short time ago a contract was

made with drillers to complete the well and it was agreed that they would be given fifteen days in which to clear the present well, and if prospects were not favorable for cleaning the hole by that time a new well was to be started. The old well was drilled by the company on the day labor plan, officers of the company employing drillers and superintending the work. The job of making the test is now up to the drillers who have the contract to go down 3500 feet or strike oil.


