Miller Gives Report on World Cotton Conference

(Continued from First Page.)

es such quality) of the middleman as Mr. Producer is. After mature consideration of this situation I know of only one remedy to suggest to producer that would possibly afford him some protection.

Being a banker and knowing that most, and especially all country bankers have the interests of all farmers at heart, and their prosperity aids the bankers prosperity, they realize that unless the producers of cotton of the entire South, realize an average price of the cost of production of the entire cotton crop, then the South as a whole, is retrograding financially.

It is also well known that the United States government keeps and makes periodical reports during the growing season of condition and probable yield of the crop. By the time of the September report a reasonably fair estimate of the lint per acre production is available.

The agricultural departments of each state are in position to ascertain the average cost of planting and growing and investment necessary to produce an acre of cotton; then knowing approximately the price of cotton to realize the cost of production. Let such price as thus ascertained be made public.

The farmer and banker, being thus advised of the average cost of production of cotton over the entire South can confer together in each locality and agree as far as in the power of each to do so, not insist on payment of his debt for advances to make his crop until said price is realized.

Thus if Farmer, Banker, Merchant, and Doctor, will stand together, this can be the only solution of this question. And if they fail to have some concert of action in the entire South as above suggested, our cotton will continue to remain the football for the middleman to kick about up and down at his pleasure.

But if we Southerners can stand together and see the bottom price of cost of production, below which it shall not go, then let Mr. Middleman kick it as high above as he chooses, but when he gets it too high for Mr. Spinner man let him then resort to his future market hedges if he should still consider them necessary for his business.

We cotton producers have never yet been able to discover any good in future dealings to aid us in getting cost of production. But it seems they shall continue as a necessary evil as far as we are concerned.

There were also many important financial problems discussed touching exchange and large credits needed to finance the European countries in buying cotton, that were excellent and approved of by appropriate resolutions. On all resolutions suggesting certain policies to be adopted by our Government, the foreign delegates very discretely refused to vote, as they did not feel it proper from them to do so.

At the opening of the convention after the welcome address was made by the Mayor of New Orleans, Mr. Behrmann, representative from England, Italy, Switzerland and France, were called on severally to respond and as each was called, all the delegates assembled rose to their feet, thus
