



### THIRTY FOUR NATIONS AT WOMEN'S CONFERENCE.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 28. -Wages, the 8 hour day, and betterment of working conditions are the principal subjects scheduled for discussion at the world conference of women-workers which opened here today under the formal title of the First International Congress of Working Women.

Women workers of 34 countries were invited to send delegates. Delagates from nearly ali countries now are here overflowing hotels and private homes in which many are guests. Others will arrive before the week ends, officials said.

Among the countries whose women workers sent delegates are Great Britain, Canada, France. Bel gium, Italy, Switzerland, Poland, Uruguay. Each was entitled to 10 district court here Monday. delegates and no limit was put on the number of secretaries and as sistants.

Nearly 500 delegate and assistants will register before the congress closes, it is predicted.


