

Up to Thursday at noon, twelve women in Runnels County had paid their poll taxes, and an ef fort is being made to get every woman in the county to pay her poll tax, and vote in the year 1920. January 31 is the last day in which these can be paid, thus comen to get busy

In addition to the state and county tax of one dollar and sev enty five cents, a city poli tax must be paid amounting to fifty cents. The county and state tax is payable at the office of the county tax collector, but the city tax must be paid at the city hall to the city secretary.






