MARKET REVIEW

NORTH FORT WORTH, July 11.—On the strength of very light receipts of cattle at this point for the opening day of the week, buyers were asking higher prices. The urgent demand from local houses gave the market a strong tone and the general trade ruled steady to 10c higher. Receipts figured close around 1,200 head, with about thirty-five cars in the pens.

The quality of steers was fairly good, and, while trading was a little slow, the bulk of offerings sold strong to 10c and in some cases 15c higher than the close of last week. A few loads of fairly well finished steers sold at a range of from \$3.90 to \$4.15, but the bulk of sales went largely around \$3.

The trade on butcher stock was very uneven. There was a good outlet for all offers, the quality of which was largely common to medium, with a few loads of fairly well-finished cows. The market ruled steady to 10c higher. Cows that just suited sold 10c higher, while other sales were no better than steady. The bulk of sales today went at a range of from \$1.50 to \$2.25.

Supplies of calves were quite liberal for such a small run, mostly of medium grades. Packers wanted the supply and trading was generally steady with the bulk of sales at a range of from \$2.50 to \$3.50.

Hardly enough hogs came in today to make a market quotation. Receipts, with one car in the pens, figured less than 100 head. The quality was medium and of light weight and though advances came in quoting lower markets at other points, trading here ruled steady, with the top at \$5.25 for those averaging 138 pounds.

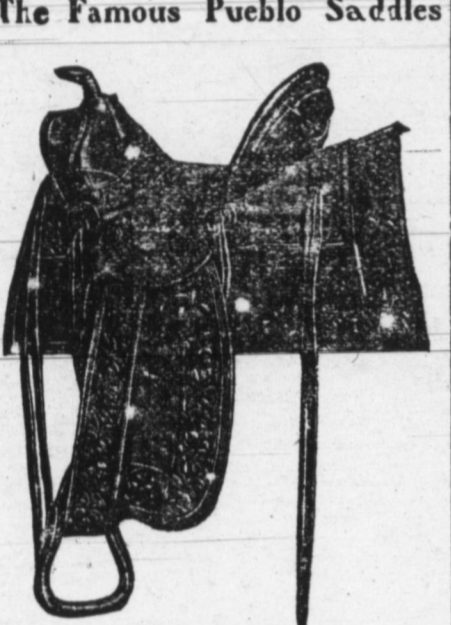

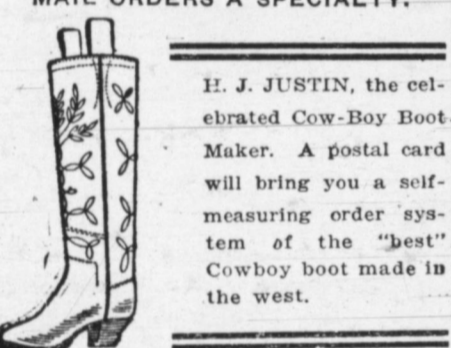
