The Commission is also asking the court to order servic restored to 26 other cities already cancelled by the bus company. In a related move, the Commis sion has asked the ICC to adminision has asked the ICC to admini- stratively stay it's Dec. 12 order which allowed Greyhound to can service is not available to those points. Acting at the request of the Railroad Commission the Railroad Commission, the state Attorney General earilier this month filed suit in the $U$. $S$. District Court of Appeals in New Orleans, asking the court to suit is pending. suit is pending. The two Commission actions this week are designed to keep Greyhound busses rolling to the affected cities while the ICC afected cities while the decision is argued in court.
