Home Economic Briefs

Breakfast is important

Every morning we are faced with a dilemma: do we eat a balanced breakfast, or feel sluggish and less alert as the day goes on? There doesn't seem to be much of a choice, yet many Americans skip breakfast, the most important meal of the day.

After eight to twelve hours without food your body is low in blood sugar when you wake up. If it isn't replenished, your brain is less alert and you function less efficiently.

Studies show that adults are the most common breakfast skippers. Only about half the people over the age of 20 eat breakfast everyday. Those between the ages

of 12 and 17 aren't much better. One third of those kids skip breakfast at least once a week.

The old excuse "I don't have time" doesn't really hold up. A well-balanced breakfast doesn't take that long to prepare and pays itself off later in the morning, when you can function better than those who skipped this important meal.

A good breakfast should include something from three of the major food groups. Simple things such as muffins, cereal, fruit, yogurt, milk, toast, eggs and cheese, in various combinations would supply enough nutrition to get your day off to a good start.

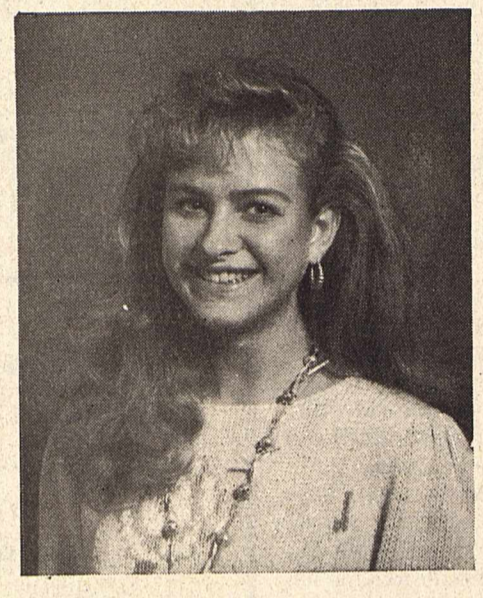

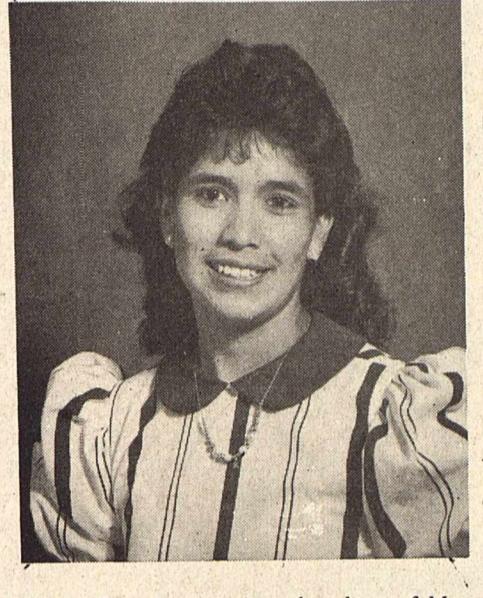

Broncos first defeat from Bearcats, 18-22

 In a heartbreaking defeat, the Broncos suffered their first defeat of the season to the undefeated Ballinger Bearcats. After a fumbled lateral was called an incomplete pass allowing the Bearcats to retain possession and ultimately score, the end of the first quarter saw the Broncos trailing 13-0. Sonora dug in during the second quarter, and Michael Harris made an incredible interception to give the Broncos the ball. With a fourth-and-eighteen from Ballinger's 27, Alex Duenes (8-15 for 170 yards) connected with Peter Perez for the touchdown. The continued offensive drives ignited the defense who held the Bearcats to a last second field goal to finish the half. This left the score at 16-6 when the teams

headed for the locker room. The third quarter was all Sonora. The Broncos cut the margin closer when Duenes found Sammy Mata on another fourth down pass for the score. In the fourth quarter, it seemed Sonora had found the key when Duenes fired a pass to the well covered Mike Fullen for a 30 yard gain. On the very next play, the pass was again successful, this time to Luie Gonzales who broke a tackle for the touchdown. Time ran out for the Broncos and they found themselves down 22-18 at the final buzzer. Sonora finished the game with a total of 110 yards rushing. Peter Perez led all rushers with 55 yards followed by Robert Harris who gained 43 yards. The Broncos look forward to seeing all their supporters Friday

night at Bronco Stadium when they host the Coahoma Bulldogs on their first ever homecoming
