Attempted Suicide.

Harris Barnes charged with the theft of two mules, and now confined in the Portales jail awaiting the action of the grand jury, attempted to take his own life last Sunday morning about 6:30 o'clock by hanging himself.

Sheriff Bain's little girl gave him a stool to sit on the day before and with the aid of this stool he tied his suspender to the bars above his cell, after tying them around his neck, and kicked the stool out from under him, and about 6:30 Sunday morning when the other prisoners found him he was black in the face, and when taken down was unconscious. Mr. Bain sent immediately for Dr. White, but Barnes had about recovered upon his arrival shortly afterwards.

Mr. Bain said Barnes played crazy for about two hours after he was cut down. This is Barnes second attempt at suicide, he having tried to kill himself several years ago.

Barnes is charged with the theft of two mules from Mr. Good... a few weeks ago, and at his preliminary hearing waived same and was ordered to await the action of the grand jury, and his bond fixed at \$1000, and not being able to make same, was committed to jail.

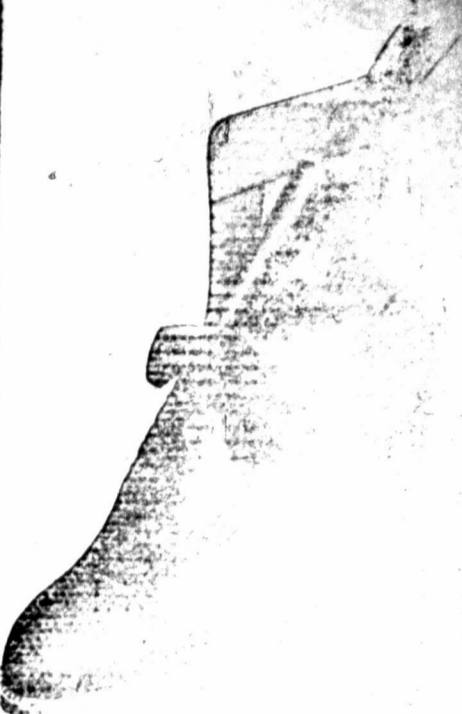

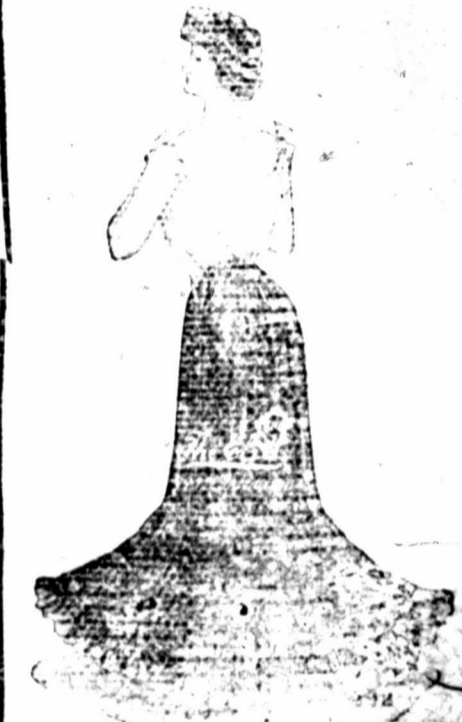
