Tax Hike Announced
By School District

| A raise in school taxes was approved for the Friona Independent School District for 1975-76, due to the new Public School Financing Law and the reduction of the assessed evaluation of district property for the current year. <br> The new Public School Financing Law imposed a greater burden on the local school systems than before, as we expected. In addition, the assessed evaluation of property (in the Friona school district) is down $\$ 1,292,422$ this year," said Superintendent of Schools Tom Jarboe relative to the increase. <br> The action came at the board's meeting July 12, and came after the group had examined the proposed school budget for 1975-76. <br> Due to the change in public school financing by the state, the Friona district is faced with raising an additional $\$ 89,000$ over the previous school year. The decrease in attributed to the small number of cattle being fed as of January 1 this year, will cause the district to need another $\$ 20,000$ in taxes. <br> The board, after much study and discussion, voted to raise the ratio on real estate from 37.5 per cent of the evaluation to 50 per cent, and | reduce the tax rate from $\$ 1.80$ to $\$ 1.55$. This would bring about an increase in real estate taxes of approximately 14.8 per cent, it was pointed out. <br> At the same time, personal property taxes (non real estate) are to be adjusted to full value. Their rate of increase will approximate 29 per cent. It was pointed out that taxes on personal property had not been adjusted since before 1964. <br> Taking everything into consideration, the school tax increase will be approximately a 17.2 per cent increase for everything averaged together-real estate and personal property. <br> Virtually every school district this part of the state is faced with increasing their taxes, as a result of the new Public School Financing Law. <br> The new law came into being after a Federal District Court ruling found the state's former method of financing to be "unfair" to certain school districts. <br> In addition to the tax increase, school officials found it necessary to raise the price of lunches in the school cafeterias for 1975-76. <br> An adjustment was made in January of this year, but the |
