AN EXPERIMENTAL HERBICIDE called Roundup may boost limited and notillage operations for farmers.
Dr. A.F. Wiese, weed scientist based at the Southwestern Great Plains Research Center, reported the control seientists at Corpus Christi to discuss the new
herbicide The herbicide shows particular promise for killing a winter

nutrients. Without doubt commercial fertilizer will retain this position but since their price is increasing and inadequate
supplies are in prospect it it time to to take a new look at feediot waste as a source of plant food.
The USDA Southwestern Great Plains. Research Center at Bushiland has been study ying the eftects of leediot waste since
1968 . Their hemical andylyes of material trom 23 teedlots show that on an averuge 10 tons of manure contains 268 libs. nitrogen.
241 lbs. P206 and 360 lbs. K20. These values are much higher than those previously reported tor batruyard manures. The matetial varied in in itrogen content with extremes being 226
and 392 lbs. in 10 tons. present in in toanch ond of matean mure, tor some some 120 lbs . of nitrogen, is available the second year and 30 lbs. nitrogen will be available
