primaries. This is probably suported by office holders, afraid that if the presidential vote was held on the
same day as the state primary, it might hurt their chances to be re-
elected. Supporters of the proposed bill, to
hold the primaries at the same time, argue that the presidential preference vote could be held in this way, at
absolutely no extra expense to Texas axpayers.
