Fifty East Texas ribbon cane grow ers, representing twenty-eight counties met in Longview this week to perfect an organization to standardize produc tion and sale of ribbon cane syrup. Plans were submitted by H. S. Paine, chemist of the United States bureau of chemistry, and Walton Peteet, director of commodities, Texas Farm Bureau Federation, a decision was reached to erect a large central plant at a cost of approximately \$25,000 to standardize as high as 500,000 gallons of syrup a year.

A revised statement on the rice crop of Jefferson County places the total at 35,000 acres.




