## Tulia Visits Friona For Friday's Game

While it's the second game of the season for the Chieftains, it will be Tulia's first outing.
The Hornets are coming off a 1-9 season in 2002, when injuries early in the campaign caused the Hornets' luck to turn into a tailspin season.
Tulia has 12 of last year's 23 lettermen back in the fold,
along with five offensive starters and five defensive starters
back. Terrence Powell, a 185 -pound senior running
back/linebacker, is the "go-to" player for Coach Eric Wilson back/linebacker, is the "go-to" player for Coach Eric Wilson.
Powell, a powerful runner, gained first-team all-district a year ago, gaining 805 rushing yards, adding 137 yards on pass catches and scoring four touchdowns. Another key to Tulia's success will be senior guard Esteban
Cortez, a 260 -pounder Wilson calls "a good, solid player." Criona and Tulia first met on the gridiron in 1933. The Hornets lead the all-time series, $26-14$ (65 per cent), although

The teams didn't meet in 1998 or 1999 , but had played
