### No Friona Star next week, a rate increase January 1

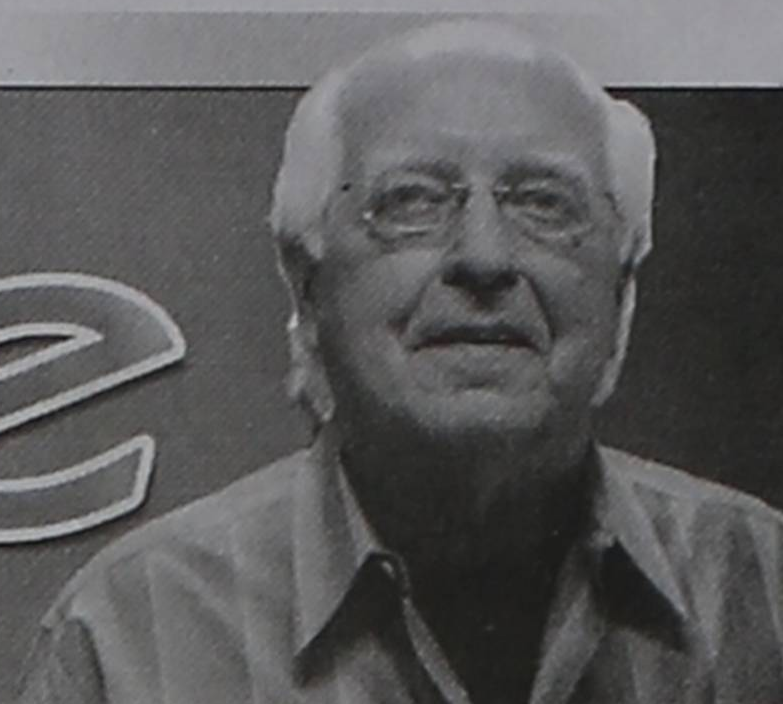

# Parmer County sales tax revenue increases

Texas Comptroller Susan Combs announced that state sales tax revenue in November was \$2.41 billion, up 2.8 percent compared to November 2012.

"State sales tax revenue continues to grow at a moderate pace as expected," Combs said. "Sales tax collections have increased for 44 consecutive months. Revenue from sectors such as wholesale trade, services industries and restaurants contributed to the most recent increase."

Combs will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts their December local sales tax allocations totaling \$579.6 million, up 5 percent compared to December 2012.

Parmer County will receive sales tax revenue of \$49,140, which is up 11.82 percent from \$43,944 in 2012. To date the county has received \$626,750, which is up 7.19 percent from \$584,704 in November of 2012.


Friona will receive \$31,968, which is up 15.44 percent as compared to \$27,691 in 2012. To date Friona has received \$399,837 as compared to \$383,480 last year. This is an increase of 4.26 percent.

Bovina will receive a November net payment of \$8,339, which is 14.43 percent higher than the November 2012 payment of \$7,287. Payments to date are \$113,499 as compared to \$92,147 during the same period last year. This is a 23.17 percent increase.

Farwell will receive a net payment of \$8,832, which is down 1.48 percent from the 2012 total of \$8,965. To date Farwell has received \$113,414 in 2013 as compared to \$109,078 in 2012. This is an increase of 3.97 percent.



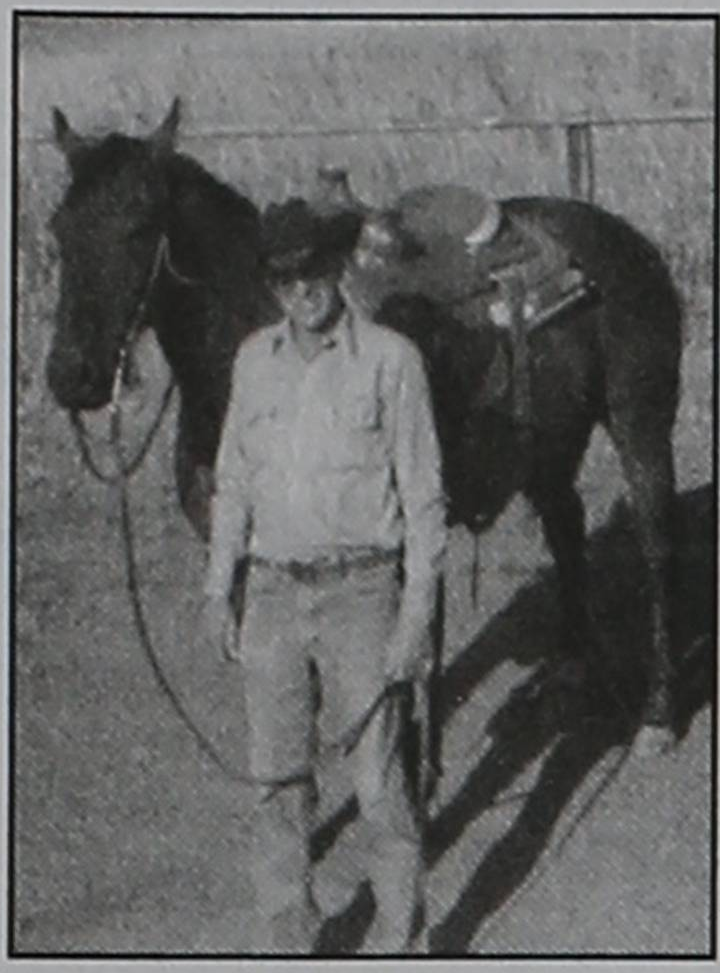
## Cleatus Rhodes

## Songs of the Season

Not every Christmas song was birthed from the joyous melodies and exuberant celebrations of Christmastime, but some songs, like this one, were birthed from one of the most trying times in our nation's history. The title of this Christmas poem, which later became set to music, has no connection with the Biblical account of Jesus' birth, but is a song that was forged by the great American poet, Henry W. Longfellow, during the American Civil War. Strong words proclaiming "And in despair I bowed my head: 'There is no peace on earth,' I said; 'For hate is strong, and mock the song of peace on earth, good will to men,'" exemplify the state of a nation that was being ravaged by deep hatred. Though the despair of the day was reality, he also recaptured the hope of Christmas that rings out in lyrics such as "Yet pealed the bells more loud and deep 'God is not dead, nor doth He sleep; the wrong shall fail, the right prevail, with peace on earth, good will to men.'" Although, these lyrics may not be too familiar, the clue is not in what you sing, but what you hear from the bells.

Although the bells may have been too obvious of a hint, this song firmly injected the hope of Christmas into a nation wearied and ravaged by war. This song is "I Heard the Bells on Christmas Day," which was only a poem for many years and later put to music. (excerpts of this article taken from Kenneth W. # Send in the Subs


Butter, yum! But yikes, the calories it packs! A cup of butter has 1,627 calories so naturally it tastes delicious. A cup of shortening has 1,845 calories and even heart-healthy oils have about 1,927 calories. Swap half of the butter, oil or shortening in a recipe with an equal amount of unsweetened applesauce or unsweetened pumpkin puree. The unsweetened applesauce has a neutral flavor and can be used in any baked good, especially cakes. Unsweetened pumpkin puree can be used in spiced breads, muffins or cakes, quick breads, pancakes or brownies. Bananas add flavor, fiber and moisture, much like oil does. Use half

of a mashed or pureed banana for every cup of oil—just be sure to use them in recipes where their strong flavor won't overpower more delicate ingredients. The article relates that since bananas are dense, they are not ideal for light and fluffy baked goods.

The article also explains that sugar is necessary in baked goods because it prevents the flours from creating gluten, which yields tough, chewy cookies and cakes. Sugar contains 775 calories per cup. Experiment with this, but you can usually reduce the amount of sugar in pie fillings, cakes and cookies by up to half. Start by reducing the sugar by 1/4 cup. If no one notices (it worked!), try reducing it by another 1/4 cup.

Last but not least, chocolate. You can save 1,050 calories in a recipe by using miniature chocolate chips in your cookies and reducing the amount by half.



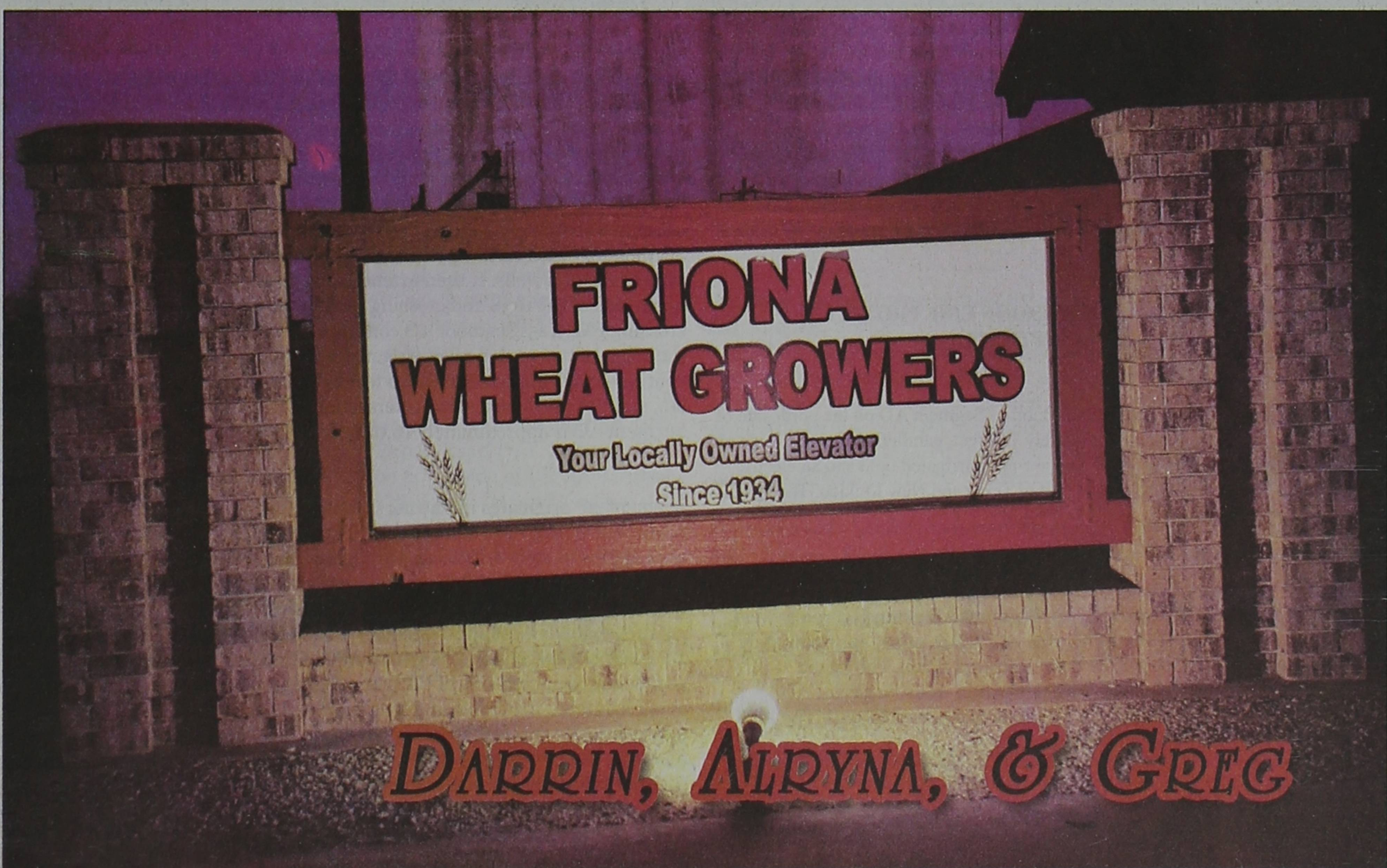

*Application of Southwestern Public Service Company to Amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for a Proposed 115-kV Transmission Line within Bailey and Parmer Counties, Texas*

PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS DOCKET NO. 41921

Southwestern Public Service Company (SPS), a subsidiary of Xcel Energy Inc., intends to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in order to construct and operate a new 115-kilovolt (kV) transmission line within Bailey and Parmer Counties, Texas. Southwestern Public Service Company (SPS) has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission or PUC) (Docket No. 41921 - *Application of Southwestern Public Service Company to Amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for a Proposed 115-kV Transmission Line within Bailey and Parmer Counties, Texas*) and is requesting the approval of the Commission for this project. This transmission line is needed for reliability purposes.

SPS, a subsidiary of Xcel Energy Inc., is proposing to construct and operate a single circuit, 115-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between the existing Bailey County Substation located in Bailey County, Texas and the existing Curry County Substation located in Curry County, New Mexico. This application addresses the project area from the Bailey County Substation in Bailey County Texas, to the Texas/New Mexico state line. The proposed transmission line was identified by the Southwest Power Pool (SPP) as needed for reliability to address low voltage violations at the Bailey County Substation during system intact conditions.

The transmission line will be constructed utilizing primarily single-pole steel structures requiring a smaller surface area than H-frame structures and eliminating the need for guy wires for corner structures. The proposed transmission line will be constructed entirely on new right-of-way (ROW) with a proposed easement width of 70 feet. The proposed transmission line is presented with eight alternative routes consisting of a combined 79 segments and is estimated to be approximately 23-28 miles in length depending on which route is selected. All routes begin at the existing Bailey County Substation located in Bailey County, Texas, approximately 0.2 miles south of Muleshoe, Texas on County Road 214. The Bailey County Substation will be expanded to include the new 115-kV bus upgrade. Up to five acres of property may be purchased to accommodate the expansion. All routes addressed in the application end at the Texas/New Mexico state line.

Depending on the route chosen, the total cost of the project in Texas, including the transmission line and substation costs, is estimated to be between approximately \$17.7 million and \$21.8 million.

SEGMENT DESCRIPTIONS

**Y**  
Segment Y originates in Parmer County at the intersection of Segment AD on the north side of CR DD. Segment Y extends directly west approximately 710 feet, paralleling the north side of CR DD, crossing the non-irrigated field south of a center-pivot irrigated field and an electric distribution line. Segment Y terminates at the state line of Texas and New Mexico. The total length of Segment Y is approximately 710 feet.

**AD**  
Segment AD originates in Parmer County at the intersection with Segment AI, northwest of the intersection of CR 1 and CR DD. Segment AD extends directly west approximately 4,750 feet, paralleling the north side of CR DD, offset approximately 40 feet north of the road to avoid two center-pivot irrigated fields. The offset of approximately 40 feet from CR DD also avoids irrigation wells. Segment AD terminates at the intersection with Segment Y on the north side of CR DD. The total length of Segment AD is approximately 4,750 feet.

**AG**  
Segment AG originates in Bailey County at the intersection of Segments AN, AS, and KF northwest of the intersection of CR 1008 and CR 14. Segment AG extends directly west approximately 2,815 feet, paralleling the north side of CR 1008, offset approximately 35 feet

north of the road to avoid irrigation wells, crossing the edge of a center-pivot irrigated field, then reaching and crossing a drainage. Segment AG continues west approximately 1,600 feet, paralleling the north side of CR 1008. Segment AG then turns southwest and extends approximately 570 feet, crossing to the south side of CR 1008 to avoid a habitable structure. Segment AG then turns west, and extends approximately 220 feet, paralleling the south side of CR 1008, and crossing CR 4. Segment AH extends directly west approximately 1,920 feet, paralleling the north side of FM 3125, spanning the edge of a center-pivot irrigated field and terminating at the state line with Texas and New Mexico. The total length of Segment AH is approximately 7,150 feet.

**AI**  
Segment AI originates in Parmer County at the intersection of Segments AJ and AK, northeast of the intersection of CR DD and CR 1. Segment AI extends west approximately 1,930 feet, paralleling the north side of CR DD across the edge of a center-pivot field, offset approximately 90 feet north of the road to avoid a habitable structure and irrigation well, reaching and crossing the continuation of CR 1. **AO**  
Segment AO originates in Bailey County at the intersection of Segment DV and JO, northwest of the intersection of CR 1038 and CR 64. **BC**

Segment BC originates in Parmer County at the intersection with Segment BG, northeast of the intersection of CR EE and CR 7. Segment BC extends directly west approximately 170 feet west to cross CR 7. Segment BC then continues west approximately 4,360 feet, paralleling the north side of CR EE, offset approximately 40 feet north of the road to cross a wetland/playa, cross the edge of a center-pivot irrigated field, avoid a habitable structure and irrigation well, cross a crude oil pipeline and then a carbon dioxide pipeline. Segment BC continues west approximately 910 feet, paralleling the north side of CR EE, reaching and crossing CR 6. Segment BC continues west approximately 50 feet to terminate at the intersection with Segment GK, northwest of the intersection of CR EE and CR 6. 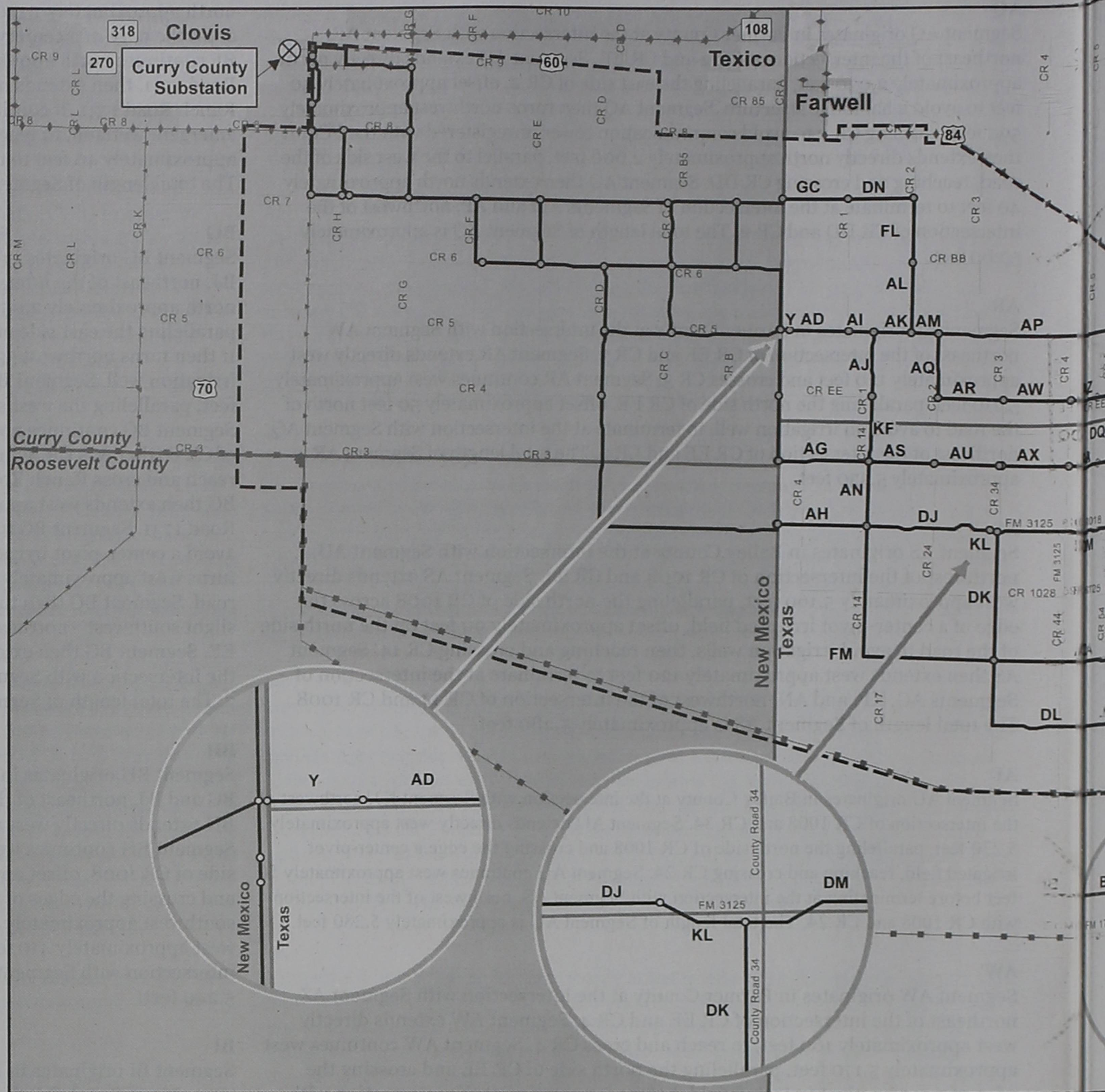

Segment BM then extends west approximately 4,250 feet, paralleling the north side of FM 3125, across the edge of a center-pivot irrigated field, and offset approximately 80 feet north of the road to avoid habitable structures and irrigation wells. Segment BM then turns northwest approximately 570 feet crossing Ranch Road 1731, before continuing approximately 110 feet to terminate at the intersection of Segment BI on the west side of Ranch Road 1731. Segment BN continues west approximately 5,270 feet, paralleling the north side of FM 1760 to cross two center-pivot irrigated fields, offset approximately 110 feet north of the road to avoid a habitable structure and irrigation wells, and then reaching and crossing CR 103. Segment BN extends directly west approximately 2,100 feet, paralleling the north side of FM 1760 before turning southwest to cross to the south side of the road. Segment BN continues west approximately 1,300 feet, paralleling the south side of FM 1760, offset approximately 105 feet south of the road to avoid a habitable structure before turning northwest approximately 500 feet to cross to



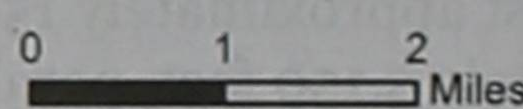
**BAILEY COUNTY SUBSTATION

Segment BP extends directly west approximately 2,430 feet, paralleling the north side of CR 1038 reaching and crossing CR 83. Segment BP continues west for 50 feet. From here, Segment BP turns north and extends approximately 3,140 feet, paralleling the west side of CR 83. BP then turns northeast approximately 510 feet crossing CR 83, then turns north, offset approximately 40 feet east of the road to avoid a habitable structure. The segment extends directly north approximately 620 feet, paralleling the east side of CR 93, crossing carbon dioxide pipeline. Segment BP continues north approximately 1,010 feet reaching and crossing FM 3125. Segment BP continues north approximately 60 feet to terminate at the intersection of Segments BM, BQ, and DR, northeast of the intersection of CR 83 and FM 3125. The total length of Segment BP is approximately 10,610 feet.

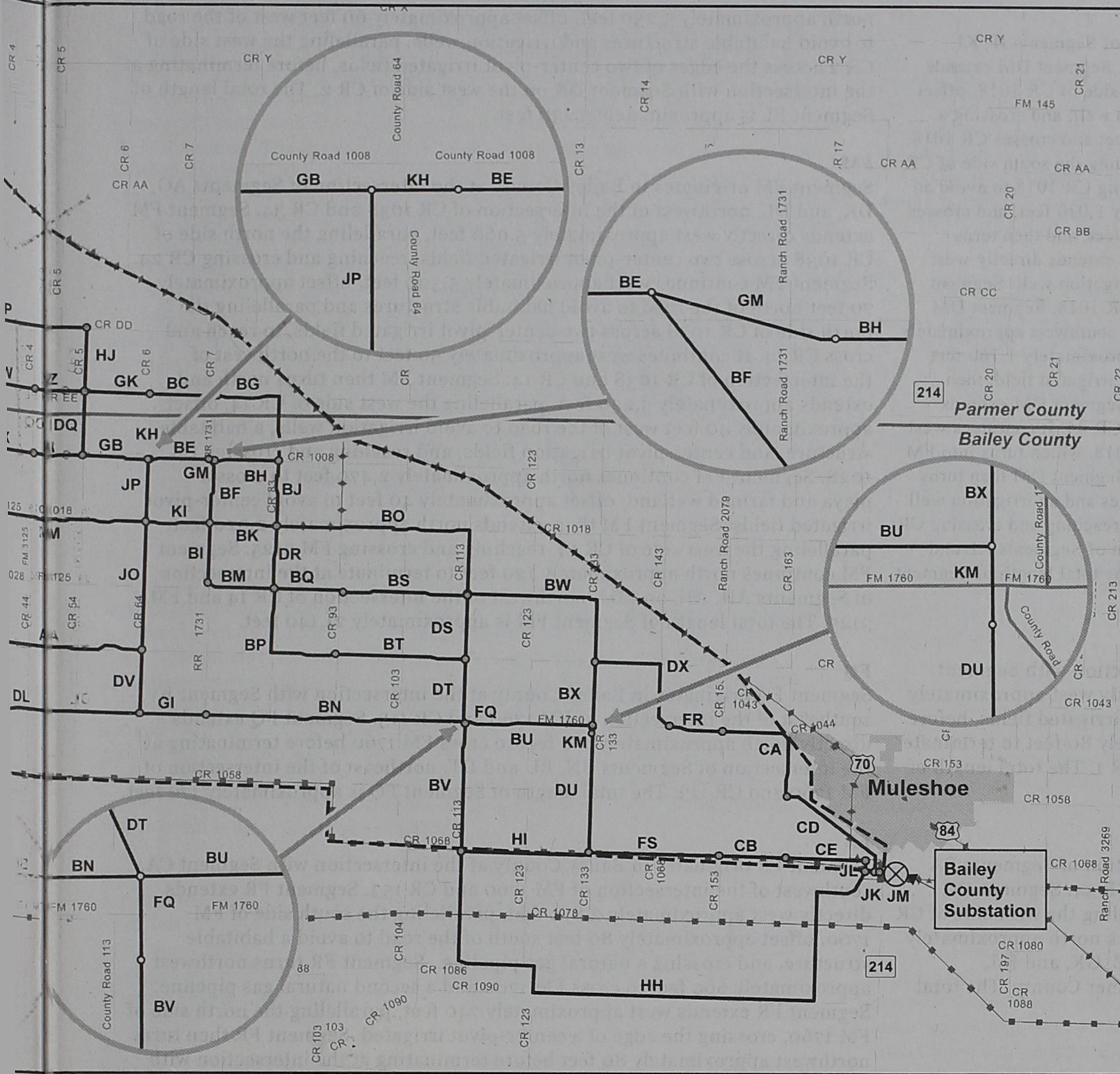

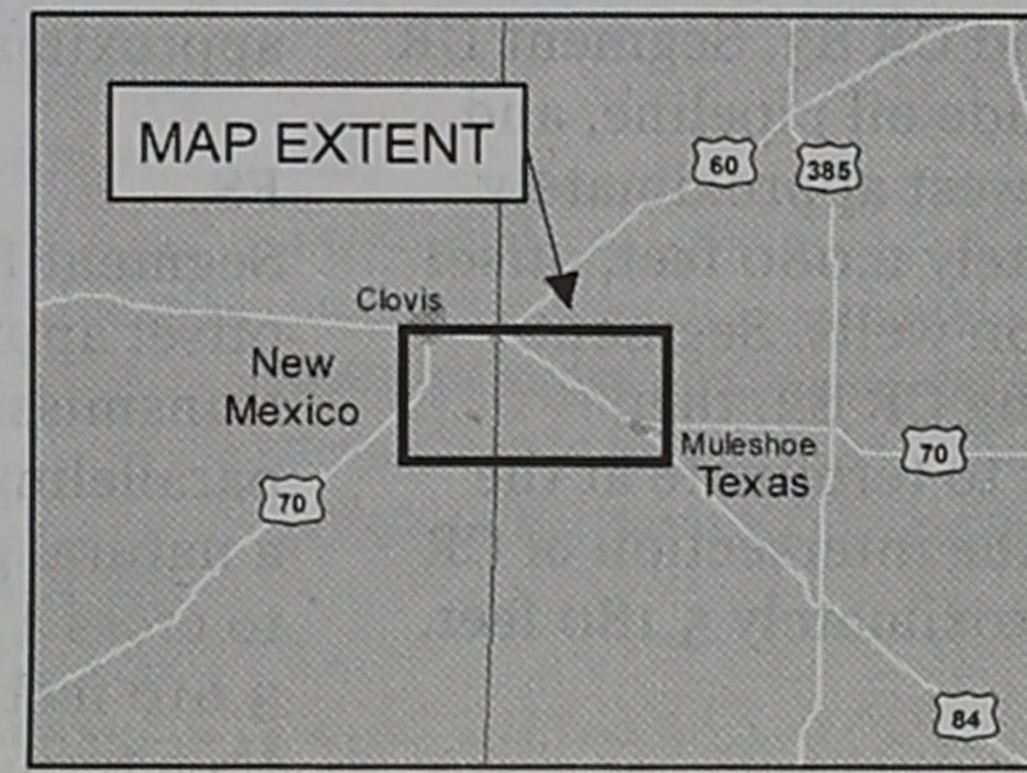
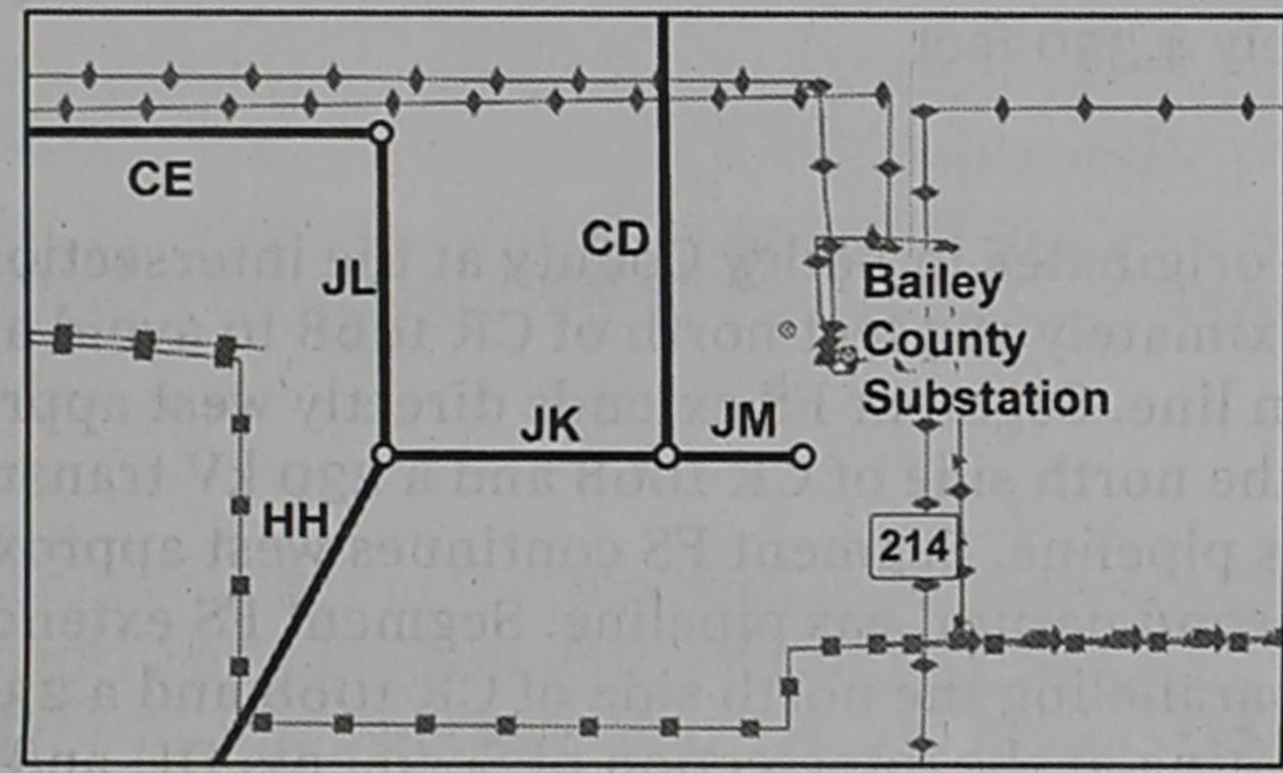

Segment KJ extends directly west approximately 160 feet, crossing CR 34, and extends an additional approximately 50 feet where it terminates at Segment AU, northwest of the intersection of CR 34 and CR 1008. The total length of Segment KJ is approximately 210 feet.

**KL**

Segment KL originates in Bailey County at the intersection of Segments DK and DM, southwest of the intersection of CR 34 and FM 3125. Segment KL extends directly west, approximately 360 feet, then turns northwest approximately 50 feet. It continues northwest approximately 130 feet crossing FM 3125. It then continues approximately 130 feet northwest to terminate at Segment DJ. The total length of Segment KL is approximately 670 feet.

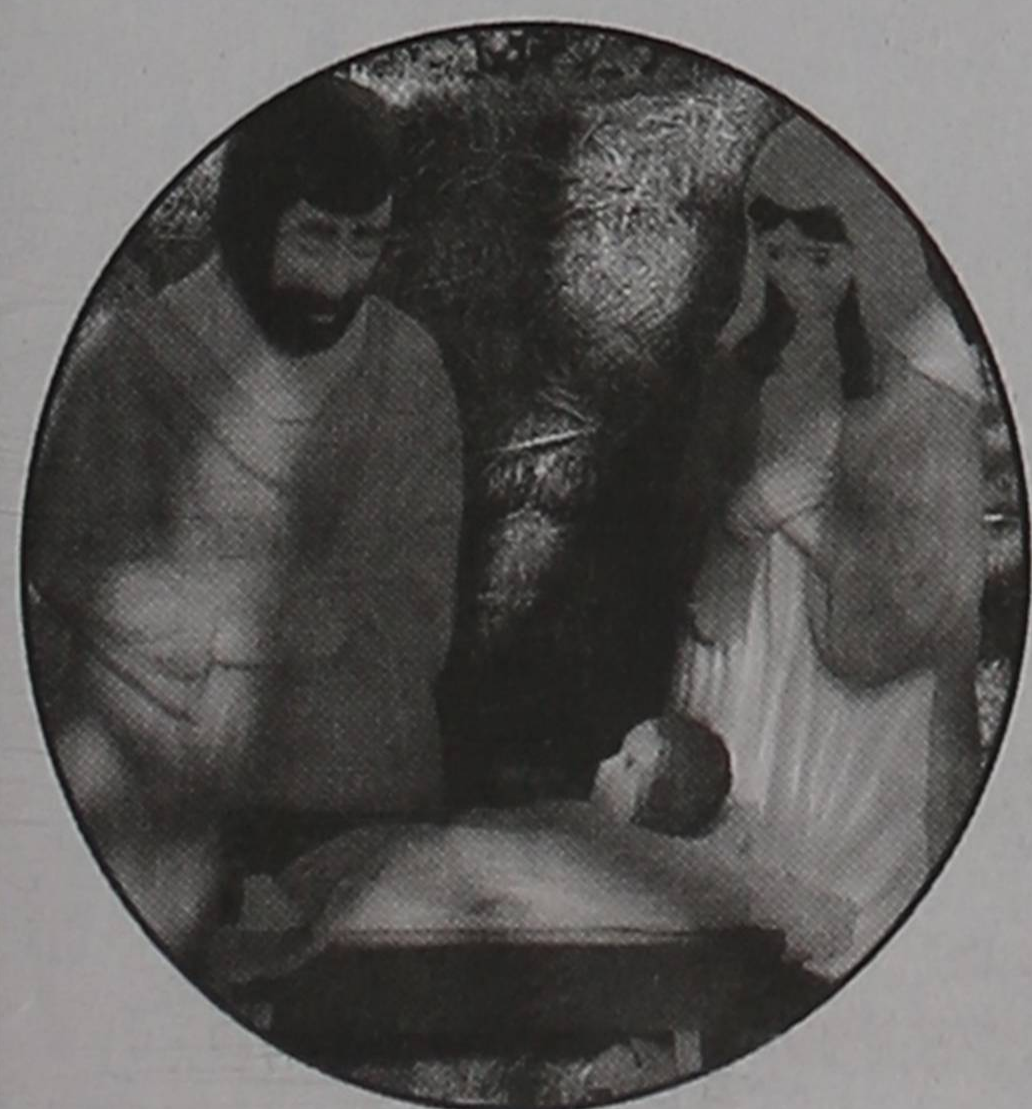

2-12.5 oz. cans chicken breast  
2-8 oz. cream cheese-softened  
1 cup Ranch dressing  
1-5 oz. bottle Frank's "Red Hot" sauce  
1 cup shredded cheddar cheese  
Drain chicken and warm in a saucepan on medium heat, breaking it up as it cooks. Add cream cheese, smashing cheese with fork. Add Ranch and hot sauce. Stir. Once it begins to bubble pour into crock-pot and cover with cheddar cheese. After cheese bubbles, stir and serve.

1 cup white sugar  
1 cup dark Karo syrup  
1 cup brown sugar  
½ lb. butter (no substitutes)  
2 cups whipping cream  
1 lb. pecans  
1 tsp. vanilla  
Combine sugars, Karo, butter and 1 cup cream in sauce pan: bring to a boil on medium heat. Add remaining cream slowly so that boiling does not stop. Allow mixture to boil and brown a little, but prevent from burning by stirring often. Cook to softball stage (245 F on cookie thermometer). Remove from heat and add vanilla and pecans. Pour in buttered pan and cool: cut into squares.
