Pinch salt
Black pep

Toss spaghetti with 1 tbsp olive oil \& set aside. In large skillet, cook bacon until crisp. Remove \&
drain on paper towels. Don't clean skillet. Discard all but 2 tbsp of bacon grease. Add remaining olive oil. Add onion and cook until tender; add garlic and cook one minute more.
Deglaze pan with wine (if desired) by adding wine to onion and garlic mixture and cooking for one additional minute. Pan may also be deglazed with water. Return bacon and spaghetti to pan. Toss to coat. (If it
seems dry or sticky, add a little more olive oil. Add beaten eges and cook until set, tossing constantly. Add Parmesan cheese, salt and pepper. Toss to combine Serve with chopped parsley and extra Parmesan chees sprinkled on top
