$2 / 3$ cup milk
In a large bowl combine biscuit mix, cheese, garlic powder, oregano, and basil. Stir in enough milk just unpowder, oregan.

Drop by rounded teaspoonfuls onto a lightly greased baking sheet. Bake at 450 for $7-8$ minutes or until golden brown. Serve warm.
