

Muleshoe's sales tax allocations for December, representing amounts collected by the state in November, showed a slight increase, according to information received from the office of Texas Comptroller Susan Combs.



"State sales tax collections through the first three months of fiscal 2008 are up 6.6 percent compared to the same period last year," Combs said. "Growth is substantially slower than the vigorous 12 percent and 10.9 percent seen in fiscal 2006 and 2007, respectively. As the pace of the U.S. and Texas economies continues to cool, we expect the growth in Texas sales tax collections will continue to moderate."

Combs sent Texas cities December sales tax allocations of \$300 million, up 9.9 percent compared to December 2006. City sales tax allocations during calendar year 2007 totaled \$3.8 billion, up 6.9 percent compared to 2006.

We had our Christmas pageant at church Sunday morning at the end of the worship hour. I loved it!

It's been a long time since we had a Christmas pageant. I think the last one was more on the order of a living nativity presentation a good bit over ten years ago. It went well-real sheep, mules, and all—but I still get cold just thinking about it. The blue hue tinting the shepherds' cheeks



had nothing to do with makeup and a lot to do with frostbite. Before that were a few other pageants that went really well, I thought. Things got pretty involved, at least by small church standards. Building a manger is one thing; building a stable in the sanctuary is another. When we remodeled several years ago, a decade or so after the last Christmas pageant, we found remnants of hay still lurking in crevices in the old carpet. Most of the kids who were the cast members are having kids of their own now. Even the Baby Jesus (the best ever, I think) looks at me now pretty much eyeball to eyeball. Time certainly does get by.

One of the really cool things about Christmas pageants is that, no matter how hard we try to keep it at bay, real life somehow always intrudes, which is a good thing. It reminds us that the people in that very first Christmas story were real, too.

Mary's feet really were hurting and swelling, just like those of any other expectant mom. Joseph was feeling the pressure

of trying to take care of his soonto-be-three family and finding it harder than he expected.

Life was hard enough. Starting a family was difficult enough. And right in the middle of the difficulty comes a bulk rate letter from some mindless governmental bureaucrat of the sort the world has "with us always" who is never happier than when people are filling out forms and standing in lines. Herod wants a count of his subjects; bureaucrats love to count. Joseph looks the letter over up and down: no exemptions for wives who are nine months pregnant. So they make the long and difficult trip.

It's hard on Mary, and watching Mary hurt is hard on Joseph. They trudge wearily into town, thankful that the donkey never ran out of gas, but—wouldn't you know it?-Bethlehem has run out of rooms. Cranky innkeepers. A cold night. And then cramps. The baby is coming!

Nothing could be more real. So on Sunday it was sort of appropriate, I suppose, when our littlest angel, perched up on a heavenly box covered with brown paper, began to wave to her foster grandparents out in the congregation. As she was waving out heaven's joy and good will toward men, the halo that was already bugging her slipped down over her face, and when she finally got it off and then back on, it was upside down.

The scene Sunday was far from perfect, I suppose. That's okay. What passes for perfect in our society is often just slickly packaged and plastic. Real is better.

God sent Jesus to save real people whose halos, if they ever had such, slipped a long time ago. A real Gift. Real love. Real favor. Real peace. For real people.

## Protecting home, family against unseen danger

Winter is here, the weather has finally gotten colder and at home the heater has been turned on.

That also means making sure the home's heatproducing appliances run the way they are supposed to. Having the heating system checked can prevent a tragedy - carbon monoxide poisoning, said Janie Harris, Texas Cooperative Extension housing and environment specialist.

"Carbon monoxide is an odorless, colorless gas that interferes with the delivery of oxygen in the blood to the rest of the body," she said. "Even though carbon monoxide will not explode, it can be dangerous - even deadly - to you and your family.'

Symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning include headache, nausea and disorientation, Harris said.

The dangerous gas can be produced inside a home if carbon-containing fuels are incompletely burned, she said.

"The gas must be exhausted to the outside," she said.

These fuels include natural gas, coal, wood, fuel oil and charcoal — the sources used most often in home heating.

The culprits include oil or gas furnaces and cooking appliances, water heaters, fireplaces and wood stoves that aren't working or vented properly, Harris said.

"Two common sources of carbon monoxide in homes in Texas are the gas furnace heat exchanger and the gas hot water," she said. "As homes have been built to be more energy-efficient, they have fewer places



where fresh air can leak into fireplace or wood stove so the home. In order for fuelburning equipment to operate correctly and safely, it must have a source of fresh air for heat the house. complete combustion. The provide the fresh air."

be created inside the house, causing these gases to be pulled back inside in a process called backdrafting, equipment and appliances in Harris said.

Other sources of carbon monoxide are unvented kerosene and gas space heaters, fireplaces, gas or wood stoves, automobile dryer at the same time. This exhaust from attached garages and tobacco smoke, in the house, pulling carbon she said.

To protect home and family suggested the following steps:

checked by a professional who will make sure the burners and vent systems are working correctly and the heat exchanger isn't cracked.

· Look at the area around the furnace to make sure enough fresh air can flow in. A home's furnace should not be in a tightly enclosed space.

· Make sure the water heater and the furnace flue have no internal obstructions or leaks near the joints.

 To test a gas water heater while the burner is on, hold a lighted match under the draft hood. The flame should burn upward.

If the match flickers downward or goes out, the exhaust may have a back flow and is releasing carbon monoxide into the house.

· Open the damper of a

backdrafting. If you use only one of the exhaust fans bathroom, kitchen or dryer the backdrafting will not likely occur."

Use carbon monoxide detectors near sleeping areas and fuel-burning appliances. Choose detectors that have Consumer Product Safety Commission and Underwriters Laboratories seals of approval.

If a carbon monoxide detector goes off, call the fire department immediately and get everyone out of the house. Anyone with symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning should be taken to an emergency room.
