## UNCLE SAM(TA) CLAUS

If Uncle Sam wants you - get there as fast as you can He might just want to give you a pat on the back and a few
thousand dollars, as he has during the past year to 125,000 hard-working federal employe It's all part of the federal government's incentive awards
program, and it cost U.S. taxpayers an estimated $\$ 25$ Instead of being curtailed, the incentives program currently is being expanded under the Administration's
1978 Civil Service Reform Act. From all appearances, it's turned out to be another costly waste of public funds, To be fair, I might go along with a program that gives
cash awards to federal employees who come up with ideas that save American taxpayers money. But that's not how it works. According to Richard Brengel, director of the program for the federal Office of Personnel Management, who are thought by their supervisors to have done a good job - which, after all, is what they are paid to do. (I will
not indulge in any jokes about showing up on time, keeping pencils sharp, or the other qualities that go into making a
