### Horse, marriage do not mix

A horse and carriage carrying members of a wedding party turned over in Laurence Harbor, N.J., but the marriage ceremony was still held.

Nicole Tripolitis, 28, was riding to the Laurence Harbor Community Church for her wedding when the horse stumbled and turned abruptly to the left.

The carriage tipped over as a result of the sharp turn, landing on the driver.

Tripolitis, her grandparents, niece and nephew were thrown from the carriage and injured as well. Meanwhile, the groom was waiting at the church for the carriage to arrive.

### Grenade granny creates havoc

A granny with a grenade sent cops packing from a police station in Edmonton, Alberta.

The drama began when a 73-year-old woman walked into the Old Strathcona community station and pulled a hand grenade from her purse — and asked if it was dangerous.

"The second I saw it, I knew what it was and the pin was out," said Sgt. Lance Lillies of the terror. "There was no point taking a chance, so we had to evacuate the station. If it had been dropped or fallen the wrong way, there was risk it would go off."

Police bomb experts went into the station after the woman, eight officers, two civilian volunteers and a prisoner were out of the building.

The woman, who said her husband brought the grenade home as a war souvenir years ago, wanted to keep it, station officer Constable Ian MacKechnie said.

"I told her she couldn't do that, and I don't think she was very happy about it," MacKechnie said.

He added that police would prefer people not bring their explosives to the station.

## Old Pete to attend presidential inaugural ball

Old Pete the mule may have taken a few short, unauthorized trips during his existence, but in January he'll get to make an official trip to Washington, D.C., for the presidential inaugural festivities.

The mule memorial will be part of the Jan. 19 Black Tie and Boots Ball put on by the Texas State Society of the nation's capital.

Muleshoe native Rick Meyers,

now a Washington lobbyist, is right in the middle of planning the event, which suddenly took on new social clout with the decision that Texan George W. Bush will become president. (Tickets to the event are "virtually impossible" to get, Meyers told the *Austin American-Statesman* last week.)

Chuck Smith represented the Muleshoe Chamber of Commerce in submitting the issue to the city council Tuesday. Since control of

Old Pete is somewhat complicated, Smith said, he had informally polled other chamber directors, the Bailey County Historical Commission and the Jennyslippers to see if anyone had any objection to shipping Old Pete to Washington.

"This is a fantastic opportunity for the city," Smith said. "It's an opportunity we can't pass up."

City Manager Rick Hanna said the mule memorial belongs to "the citizens" — i.e., the city.

Mayor Victor Leal said his main concern at this point would be to get the statue to Washington and back in place as safely and rapidly as possible, so as not to disrupt the visitors who stop to have their picture made with the statue.

The city is expected to make arrangements to get Old Pete to Lubbock, from where he will journey to Washington with a covered wagon and windmill from the Texas Tech Ranching Heritage Center.

## Board selects Barrett as new school trustee

Bruce Barrett was sworn in Tuesday night as a new trustee of the Muleshoe Independent School District by Bailey County Judge Marilyn Cox.

Barrett replaces Thurman Myers, who formally resigned his position during a special board meeting Monday.

Barrett will finish an at-large term that expires in May.

Thurman left the board in order to allow the district to hire his sister-in-law, and he told the board this is a good course of action. "She has the kids' best interest at heart, and she has taught here for 10 years before," he said.

He also told the board he felt he was leaving at a time when "a good team" is in place, both board-wise and administration-wise. He singled out Superintendent Gene Sheets, saying "the team made a very good decision in hiring you."

Adrian Meador, assistant superintendent for instruction, said Myers had been an effective board member who will "be missed school-wide."

Superintendent Gene Sheets, who is new to the district himself, emphasized that the board wanted to get new faculty in place before the end of the current semester (which ends Thursday), and the state nepotism law required that if a board member resigned under these circumstances, a new board member had to be appointed before the hiring could proceed.

Two juniors also won first-team honors on defense as well as recognition on the other side of the ball. Lincoln Riley was the district's first choice as a punter

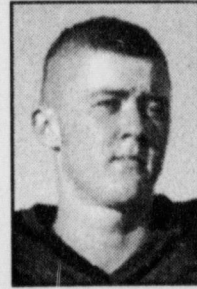

**Cost of doing good for holiday often deductible**

AUSTIN — Perhaps the holiday season includes volunteering at a homeless shelter or organizing a gift collection, or maybe even dressing as Santa at a party for disadvantaged children.

If so, the Samaritan in question may be able to take income-tax deductions for transportation to and from the shelter, for publicizing the gift drive, and for renting the Santa Claus suit.

• Automobile expenses — The cost of operating a vehicle in connection with volunteer work is deductible. There are two ways to claim it.

The actual cost of gasoline and oil for driving to and from meetings, fund-raising events and other charity-related work can be deducted. Or, if preferred, a flat 14 cents per mile can be claimed for driving that is directly related to charitable activities.

Under either method, parking fees and tolls are deductible.

General repairs and maintenance, depreciation, registration fees or any part of the cost for tires and insurance cannot be deducted.

Also, vehicle-related expenses cannot be deducted unless the charity directly benefits from the efforts involved. For example, the cost of driving several Girl Scouts to meetings on a regular basis cannot be deducted because the children receive the primary benefit rather than the organization.

• Meal and travel expenses

— The cost of airfare or other transportation when volunteer work requires an overnight stay out of town can be deducted.

Costs of meals and lodging while away on official charity business may be deducted.

Deductible travel expenses include air, rail and bus transportation, taxi fares and reasonable lodging costs and meal expenses.

Because these travel expenses are not business-related, they are not subject to the same limits as business deductions.

Such expenses are not deductible if the trip involves only nominal duties or, if for significant parts of the trip, there are no charity-related duties or responsibilities.

The IRS says it is OK to have a good time, but if there is a significant amount of personal pleasure, recreation or vacation associated with the

travel, a charitable deduction is disallowed.

• Incidental expenses — The cost of buying, laundering and dry-cleaning a uniform for volunteer work is deductible as long as the uniform is not suitable for everyday wear.

The cost of stamps and stationery, materials and supplies to publicize an event is deductible; the cost of ingredients for a cake baked for a church fund-raiser is deductible; and the cost of long-distance telephone calls made in connection with charity work is deductible.

Not deductible are the value of time or services donated to charity, the cost of child care while the parent does charity work, or the cost of using a home or office for meetings related to charity work.

• Reporting requirements — For tax purposes, unreimbursed out-of-pocket expenses are considered cash

contributions and are reported as itemized deductions on Schedule A. The total of all charitable contributions made during the year is generally limited to 50 percent of one's adjusted gross income. (In rare cases, 20 percent or 30 percent limits apply.)

# Diabetes mellitus and its potential dangers can be controlled

Diabetes. Oh, if you have it, doesn't that mean you just can't have sweets? Not too much of a problem, true?

No, not true.

Look at the possible results of having uncontrolled diabetes — blindness, irreversible kidney failure, amputations, heart disease, stroke, complications in pregnancy.

Diabetes mellitus was the sixth leading cause of death in Texas in 1998, increasing from 4,753 deaths in 1997 to 4,888 in 1998.

Diabetes is a serious disease. With it, the body either does not produce insulin (Type 1 diabetes) or does not effectively use or produce adequate amounts of insulin (Type 2

diabetes).

The hormone insulin allows sugar or glucose to enter cells and be used for energy. Insulin also is needed to make protein and store fats. In uncontrolled diabetes, sugar and fats remain in the bloodstream and, with time, damage vital organs.

Officials of the Diabetes Program at the Texas Department of Health estimates that more than 1 million Texans age 18 and older have diabetes. About 890,000 of these — 6 percent of the state's population — have been diagnosed, and the remainder are not aware they have the disease.

In Texas, African-Americans, Hispanics, Asian-Americans and people

who are overweight are more likely than others to develop diabetes. In 1999 in Texas, 7.8 percent of African-Americans, 7.1 percent of Hispanics and 5.6 percent of whites and other ethnic groups had diagnosed diabetes. A family history of diabetes, high or low blood sugar, limited physical exercise and being age 45 or older also point to those who may develop diabetes.

"Early detection, good care and education on self-management are essential for people with diabetes," said Dr. Philip Huang, chief of the Health Department's Bureau of Disease, Injury and Tobacco Prevention.

"These steps are especially vital to take since the inci-

dence of this type of diabetes linked to obesity, Type 2, has jumped significantly in children and adolescents as the percentage of overweight youngsters has increased," Huang said.

Once diagnosed, careful management of diabetes is vital to prevent or delay serious complications and premature death.

"There is no known cure," Huang said. "Diabetes is certainly treatable, but it is a chronic condition that people must learn to deal with daily."

Among the keys to keeping diabetes in check are:

- Eat healthy meals and snacks that can include veggies such as carrots, celery or cucumbers, small fruits such as apples or oranges; popcorn; or

a small bagel;

- Take the proper medicine;
- Monitor blood sugar and keep a daily log;

- Exercise at least three times a week for 20 minutes;
- Live a healthy lifestyle including no smoking, less stress, adequate sleep and avoiding excessive alcohol;

- Lose weight (if overweight) and then maintain the recommended weight;

- Reduce and control high blood pressure;

- Adjust meal plans and exercise to keep blood sugar in the desired range;

- Check and take special care of feet and skin every day; and
- Make and keep follow-up appointments with health care providers.

Symptoms of diabetes may include blurred vision, fatigue and a lack of energy, extreme thirst or hunger, frequent urination, sudden weight change, numbness or tingling in hands or feet, slow healing sores or cuts, frequent infections or depression.

Many of these symptoms go unnoticed, so people most likely to develop diabetes should be tested. Current guidelines also recommend that everyone age 45 and older consider being tested every three years.

In addition, people with diabetes should get pneumococcal and annual influenza vaccinations because diabetics are more likely to die from complications of pneumonia and flu.
