WINTER STORM GOLIATH:


Lynn County, South Plains snowed in

ynn County and a large portion of the South Plains was snowed in after Christmas, after a monster storm, dubbed "Winter Storm Goliath" by the National Weather Service, spread a swath of snow and ice accompanied by strong winds through the Midwestern United States on Sunday and Monday and impacting parts of the Northeast Monday night through Tuesday. Parts of 11 states were under winter storm warnings from north Texas to Michigan, as the storm system brought a broad mix of weather from tornadoes and flash floods to blizzards and freezing rain.

The Texas panhandle was under a blizzard warning along with eastern New Mexico and parts of Oklahoma, and three tornadoes, including an EF-4 tornado, which typically has wind gusts of between 166 and 200 mph, hit the Dallas area, killing 11 people and damaging hundreds of buildings.

Locally, the storm dumped a thick layer of ice and then topped it off with 8-11 inches of snow in the Lynn and Lubbock County areas, causing road closures and hazardous driving conditions on those roads that remained open. Thundersnow and lightning was observed here and in other parts of (See WINTER STORM GOLIATH, page 3)




The class begins January 19th, and ends May 7th. Class size is limited to 20 people.




Visitation was held at 1:00 p.m. Monday, December 28, at White's Funeral Home in Springtown.

west Texas on Sunday afternoon. Due to the hazardous road conditions, many travelers were stranded and the First Baptist

Church of Tahoka welcomed those who needed a place a stay, housing 30 people on Sunday night. About a dozen volunteers stayed with them, during shifts, and PJ's Catering fed them breakfast, according to Tahoka Mayor John Baker.

Baker, who is also the Director of Lynn County EMS, said that the EMS had made 14 ambulance runs from Christmas Day through Tuesday morning, and there were numerous calls as well throughout the day on Tuesday.

Lynn County Sheriff's deputies were all called in to work when the ice and snowstorm hit, mostly coming to the aid of stranded vehicles on highways and other roads in the county. Deputies assisted 33 stranded motorists during the four days since the winter storm hit, with the first call coming in at 1:33 a.m. Sunday, and continuing through Tuesday morning at last report, with a rollover accident on FM 211 Tuesday morning.

Stranded motorists were all over the county, from north and south of Tahoka on Hwy. 87, to east and west on Hwy. 380, and county roads and farm-to-market roads as well. Five rollover accidents, mostly minor and none involving local drivers, occurred on Hwy. 87. Deputies reported that one woman became lost during the heavy snow as she was traveling northbound from the Midland area, and turned off US 87 and lost her sense of direction, calling 9-1-1 for help. Deputies finally found her about 3 miles west of US 87 out in the middle of a field, near County


