O'Donnell High School students take stand for Ten Commandments display at school

Donnell Superintendent Dr. Cathy Amonett had a gut feeling that she might be starting a controversy by painting The Ten the high school common's area. But she did it anyway
"I didn't ask anyone's permission. I just did it. I believe in it," she said in August when interviewed for the Lamesa Press-Reporter Back-ToSchool issue.
After receiving a letter from the reedom From Religion Foundation on Wednesday saying that they had Dr. Amonett covered up the Ten Commandments and the Biblical verse with black paper.
The students didn't like the censorship and took matters into their down the black paper.
And to strengthen their resolve many students began to write Biblical verses on post-it notes and pieces of paper taping them to the walls. Some of the notes were taped together to spell "God" and to form crosses. ondary students to a school assembly where she toid them. "T'm just as frustrated as you."

She explained that until she looked into the matter more closely. Bible would have to keep the painted cover the Ten Ced. She chose to cover the Ten Commandments with an American flag. She publicly stated that she, herself, had not received any complaints, only encouragement and
calls of solidarity with the students "I'm so proud of my kids. I have to protect the school district, but 1 also want to honor them (the students)" said Dr. Amonett. "They've handled this very maturely, very respectuilly. It's something they feel strongly about and they are d
tive about i.".
Dr. Amonetl added that her teachers are using the situation as a teaching experience.
