[COMMUNICATED]  
 To the Editors of the S. A. Herald:  
 GENTLEMEN:—San Antonio is likely to come to grief if the insane hatred of John Ireland can accomplish it. He occupies the position of Chairman of the Democratic Executive Committee of Texas, a position of great honor and respectability, and one which has heretofore been filled by some of the ablest and most distinguished of the party; men as noted for their unselfishness and impartiality as they were for their earnestness, zeal and fidelity in the discharge of their duties; men by whose enlightened supervision of the political field, the Democratic party was able, in four years after being completely prostrated in the State; to obtain the most decisive victory in Texas which has ever been achieved in this or any other Southern State.  
 John Ireland, defeated in his ambition for the Governorship in the last Democratic Convention, was solaced with the appointment to the Chairmanship of the State Executive Committee. Alas! in an evil hour, we apprehend, whether for the success of the party or the good of society, influenced by an insensate fury against San Antonio, and blinded by his selfish prejudices, he has adopted a course of such supreme folly, which if not soon corrected, will give the Radical party the Congressman from the 6th District.  
 Mr. Payne, whom Mr. Ireland has made Chairman of the Executive Committee for the 6th Congressional District, if a Democrat at all, is only known as such to Judge Ireland. He has designated the town of Goliad, the place of his (Payne's) residence, for the nominating Convention to hold its sessions. To the town itself or to the courtesy and hospitality of its inhabitants, there can be no objections, but when one reflects that its location is not central, on the contrary, is at one side of this very large geographical district, the objection to its being selected for that purpose becomes paramount. Besides, not only is it out of the way, but there is not a line of stages, or other public conveniences, of any kind, running to, or even belonging to the town of Goliad.  
 Again, composed as this district is, of some fifty counties or more, any thing approaching a full attendance of the delegates, would prove utterly beyond the capacity of its hotels, and very many would be found without a shelter, or even where to lay their wearied heads, unless the proverbial hospitality of Texans should throw open their doors, in charity, to the homeless delegates. In all candor we ask, what sort of an outlook does this present for frank conference, calm deliberation, or what is of far more importance the success of the party? We never entirely approved of the strictures of the HERALD upon Ireland's course, but if he and Payne, his protage, have not placed the Democratic flag upon a two wheeled vehicle, drawn by oxen or asses, then we acknowledge we have entirely mistaken the current of events.  
 It has been the established usage of the party to select the Chairman of the Executive Committee from the most populous portions of the District, because of facilities for communicating generally with the different sections, receiving their suggestions and promptly taking heed to their counsels. And our experience in the past, has stamped beyond carping, the wisdom of such a custom. It is true, San Antonio, although the largest city in the State, save one, was never selected. The error, though a grave one, is not to late to be corrected, and we ask Judge Ireland and Mr. Payne, to do so at once, or prepare themselves to bear the odium of defeating the party—unless the people, rejecting their leadership spontaneously, select a more suitable location, and invite the different county delegates to meet at such location.  
 The party does not belong to John Ireland, and Payne has yet to show that he belongs to it, and we hope that the happy combination, will find themselves unable to use, for selfish, if not malicious purposes, the largest and one of the most intelligent Districts of the State.  
 We think public attention should be called to this matter at once, and the error, to call it by no harsher name, corrected, before it has put back the party to the days of "Reconstruction."
