# What The NRA Means To You 

## The Consumer

The welfare of the consumer is directly concerned with bringing to pass great mass consumption and greater purchasing power for the individual. The wel fare of the individual is so interwoven with the welfare of the nation that the two are inseparable. To consider the problem otherwise would be to take a selfish view of our national welfare.

It is logical to believe that greater consumption of cotton goods for instance will create a better price for the farmer's cotton, a greater consumption of beef will bring a better price for cattle and likewise a greater consumption of oil will bring better crude oil prices.

## Producer and Seller

Without cooperation of the producer, seller and the consumer, the NRA can not measure up to its full purpose. The producer and seller is expected to aid in the restoration of normal employment for the nation by shortening working hours for the employee and by adding more employes to the payroll if pos-sible-The real purpose of the NRA is to place em ployment on the shoulders of industry, give the needy an opportunity to earn a living by efforts of the individual and take the idle out of the bread line.

This problem is not solely one of the merchant or business man, but one of the consumer as well. Restoration of normal times means a greater buying power for the nation and a return of better financial conditions.

The merchant or business man can not assume the responsibilities incidental to aiding employment without support from the public. He must have a fair operating profit.
