one will be outlined b-y an in videakhand vise will alway e acceptable: but the technique nd methods to be useḑ in hand ing the machinery will be left the men operating regularly this work
The terrace lines must be run advance of the tractor. The ounty agent will be used fo this free of charge and where ill ber is to be buit a furrow will be plowed in order to make the work of the machinery fast , where ditches are to be made nd grubs to becleared so that he machinery will not be delay d. Terrace lines can be runt ny time now and marked, and people planning this work should make arrangements for this ays.
The tractor will operate for a charge of $\$ 3.50$ per hour running time. No man will be liable $t o$ breaks to machinery or other deays such as freezing, filling of for tractor, but will be charged grader are actually running, This wiil be for cash only as will be impossible for any Com misşioner to extond credit this work. The money for this work will be paid to the Com missioners.
Several men in several commu nities have been requested $t$ block the acreage to be terraced
or rather list it and file it with the County Agent's of
list of men wishing this work should be turned in at once, and anyone wishing the use of this machinery should inquire around this, as it will be impossible to come to one man, and when the tractor starts and lezve munity there will be very little chance to get it baek.
