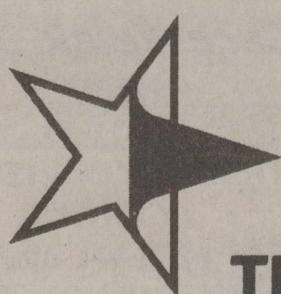


CARLOS GONZALEZ
