medicare contributions, etc. are $74 \%$ of the expenses of the center. The remaining $26 \%$ of the budget is used for utilities, property and

weakness is the lack of adequate outdoor play area and equipment. The board has raised money to
purchase additional property from Alma Lee McMahen and to hire Cooperative Playground of Austin
