Rent Director Warns of Failure To Register Units

A preliminary compliance survey has revealed that numerous rental dwelling units in the Wichita Falls, Texas area have not been registered at the rent office, Andrew E. Gilbert, area rent director, has announced.

Although the official 45-day registration period has ended, landlords who have not registered their units should do so at once at the rent office, the director said.

Landlords who fail to register may be faced with the penalty of retroactive payments to the base date, Sept. 1, 1950, if rents for their units are higher than those generally prevailing and the unit is found to be unregistered, the rent official warned.

On the other hand, if the unit is registered, no retroactive payments will be involved, should the rent be found to be above that comparable for similar type units.

The area rent director emphasized that registration of units does not mean reports must later be made periodically. After the registration, there are no other reports to fill out. Rent office personnel will assist landlords in filling out registration forms, or the forms

may be filled out at home and mailed to the rent office.

All rental dwelling units in this area must be registered, including apartments, rented homes, hotels, rooming houses, tourist courts, trailer camps and rooms in private homes.

Three types of forms are used. One covers apartments and houses. Another is for rooming houses, motor courts, trailer camps, rooms rented in the landlord's own home and similar accommodations. The third is for hotels.

Completed forms must show the rental charged on September 1, 1950, the base rental date for this area. Generally, the maximum rent for an accommodation will be the rent in effect on this date.

However, if the landlord made a major capital improvement or increased his services, after the base date, he may register the first rent charged after the change was made. This increased rental will be approved as the maximum rent if it is in keeping with comparable rentals in the area. The registration form should show the changes made and the cost of the capital improvements or increased services which resulted in an increase in rent.

Units which had not been built or which for other reasons were not on the rental market on the base date should be registered at the first rental which was charged after that date. Similarly, units which are placed on the rental market in the future must be registered within 30 days after they are first rented.

In the case of accommodations which in the future are rented for the first time, the landlord may rent the property at any figure he considers fair. However, that rental is subject to review by the rent office and will be reduced if it is appreciably above rentals for comparable units.

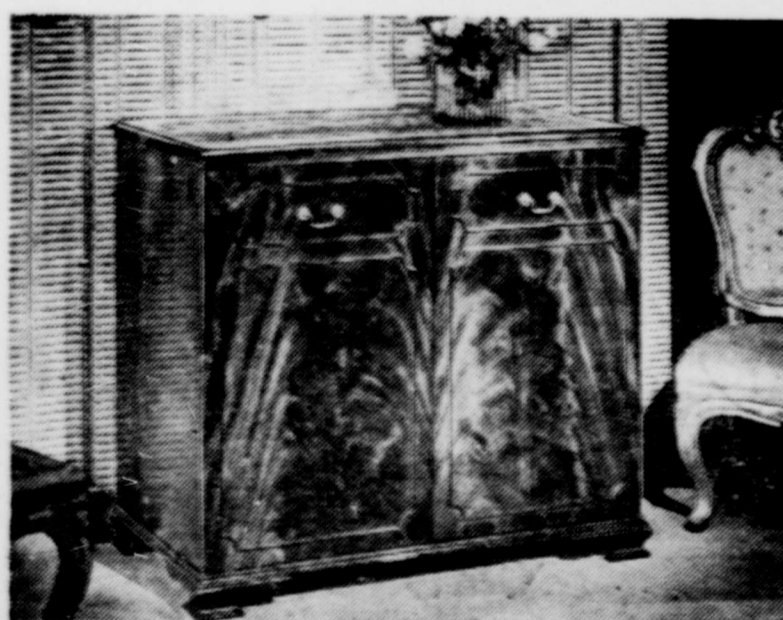

CORN CHIP ZIPPY CHEESE ...new variety for meals

No need to sacrifice either flavor or nutrition when you have tasty dishes like these. They are easy on the budget, too. Just for example, help your family to six or eight big servings of Zippy Cheese for about sixty cents, and the milk, cheese and corn chips gives you folks a bonus.

ZIPPY CHEESE Serves 6-8 1 1/2 cups milk 2 eggs 1/2 tsp. dry mustard 1 1/2 tsp. salt 1/4 tsp. cayenne 1 cup onions (chopped) 2 cups grated American cheese 1 cup crushed "Fritos" corn chips (measured after crushing) Directions: Add heated milk to slightly beaten eggs and seasonings. Mix onions, cheese, and corn chips together and place in a greased baking dish. Pour milk and eggs over this and bake at 325 degrees for 20 minutes.
