## Vietnam Blame

A staff study by the Senate Foreign Relations Committee
of the Pentagon Papers finds that secret decisions mad
in 1961 by President office sharply deepened U．S．involvenent in the tragic war． The staff study found that secrecy surrounding the Ken－
nedy Administration decision in 1961 to put U．S．soldiers nedy Administration decision in 1961 to put U．S．soldiers
into combat in South Vietnam was＂urprecedented．＂That intw combat in south Vietham was＂unprecedented．＂That
secrecy extended to members of Congress and covered the
sigmificant fact that the South Vietnamese Government was significant fact that the South Vietnamese Covermment was
not particularly eager for U．S．troops to enter into combat there－whieh the Kennedy Administration was in 1966 pro－
posing．（President Dwight Eisenhower resisted such pro－ posing．President Dwight Eisenhower resisted such pro－
posals for the preceding eight years，refusing to allow U．S．military personnel to be sent into combat．）
