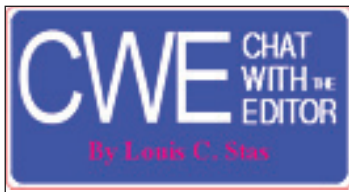

narcissistic desires – it is just something enjoyable (until it's not – but isn't everything like that; doesn't everything become unenjoyable after a certain point; it's just that those most enjoyable activities require a higher dosage before they become stale, disinteresting, or unpleasurable), and something that I've found adds value to my life. But writing about things which I think about, tends to border on the narcissistic, or comes off as self-absorbed, neither of which are desirable states to inhabit, much less to convey.

This is complicated by the fact that the act of writing could suggest I believe I have something to say, and something meaningful enough to be written down, and potentially read. I don't necessarily agree with this supposition, yet I acknowledge the undeniability of its implication. I may disclaim it, but should I make such disclaimer, one could read in to it in such a way that by making the disclaimer, I merely proved that which I set out to disclaim. (Here a pithy analogy would be fitting, to drive home a point which seems somewhat obtuse, but I find myself unable to think of one. I told you that for the moment, I am out of ideas.)

I suppose the crisis of faith with respect to the worth of writing my thoughts parallels the general malaise felt by many, especially in light of the coronavirus pandemic, which has now impacted us in the United States for almost nine months – the desperation associated with questioning the meaning of many things – but that is another topic, so I will leave it at that and bring this piece to a close. And regrettably I see that I did manage to write about myself. Ego knows no bounds.

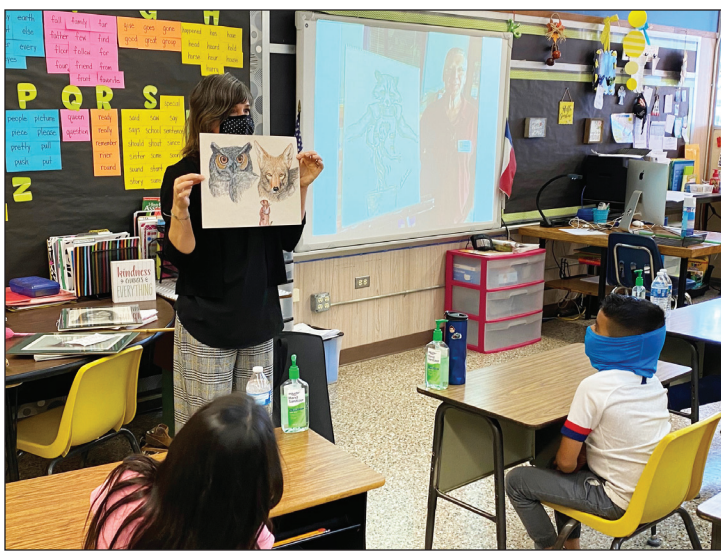

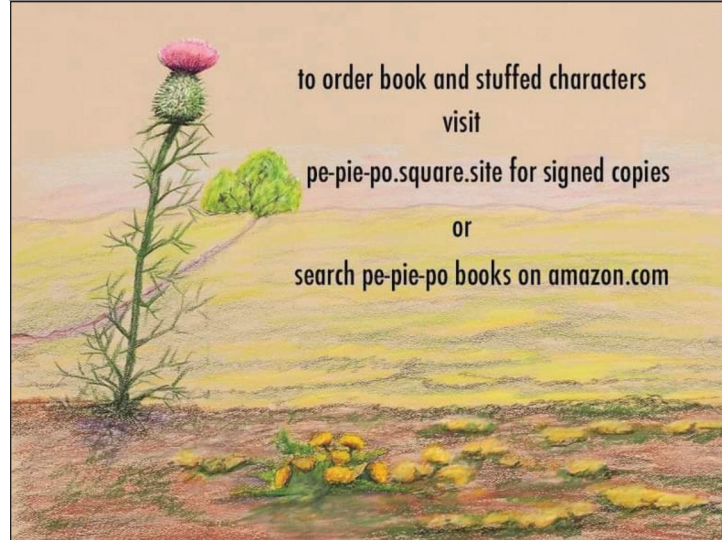

Donley/Wheeler Joint County Broadband Initiative

WHO is involved?

The Donley & Wheeler Counties' Joint Broadband Committee is comprised of local community leaders from various sectors with a common mission of enhancing and expanding broadband **access, adoption** and **use** throughout the county for the benefit of local residents and businesses. To that end, the Committee has partnered with Connected Nation Texas and their "Connected Community" program to assess the present state of broadband in Donley and Wheeler Counties and establish a broadband planning process and plan to address our current and future broadband needs.

WHAT is being done?

To perform an assessment of Donley and Wheeler Counties' current broadband environment, the Committee will be conducting surveys of local residents, businesses and other organizations across the county. Responses to these surveys will help us better understand the existing resources and capabilities we now have to support our **access, adoption** and **use** of broadband technology in our homes and businesses. After a structured evaluation of this assessment, we'll then develop appropriate action plans and projects to improve our broadband environment most effectively.

WHEN will this take place?

Our Joint Community Broadband Assessment and related surveys will be launched in August and continue into the November timeframe. Results from this work will be shared with the public, followed by additional work to develop a county-wide Action Plan to address identified areas of need.

HOW can you help?

Your participation in the appropriate broadband survey and overall support of our efforts are very important in developing an accurate assessment of broadband availability and related needs in Donley and Wheeler Counties.
