Hello Friends, Family and Readers of *The Wheeler Times!*
When I was born in Wheeler back in 1944, of course I didn't know the support system already in place. My Adams grandparents reached out with loving arms. My Harmon grandparents, Charlie and Maye, and Aunt Betty were now in Artesia, New Mexico. The Adams offspring

were all married; Winona and John Kongs, Marshall and Ruby, Clyde and Glennis, Walter and Agnes, Carroll and Roberta. And of course, my parents, Bonnie and Calvin Harmon.
It was war time – World War II. Uncle Walter and Uncle Carroll were in the Coast Guard, Uncle Tickle (Harold Herman) Harmon was in the Air Force, Uncle Harlan Harmon in the Navy. Daddy was in the Army, traveling the country training infantry troops.

Everyone in the whole United States was contributing to the war effort. Women were taking the places of men in factories building planes, tanks and other military equipment. Victory gardens sprung up in backyards. Many goods were rationed and citizens used ration cards to get almost everything. Grandmother Adams and Mother ordered quilt kits from Herschnerr's in Philadelphia to keep their hands and minds busy.

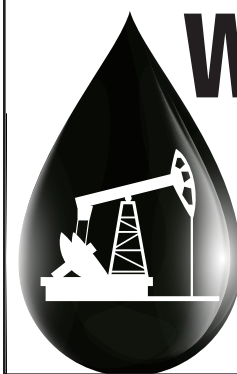

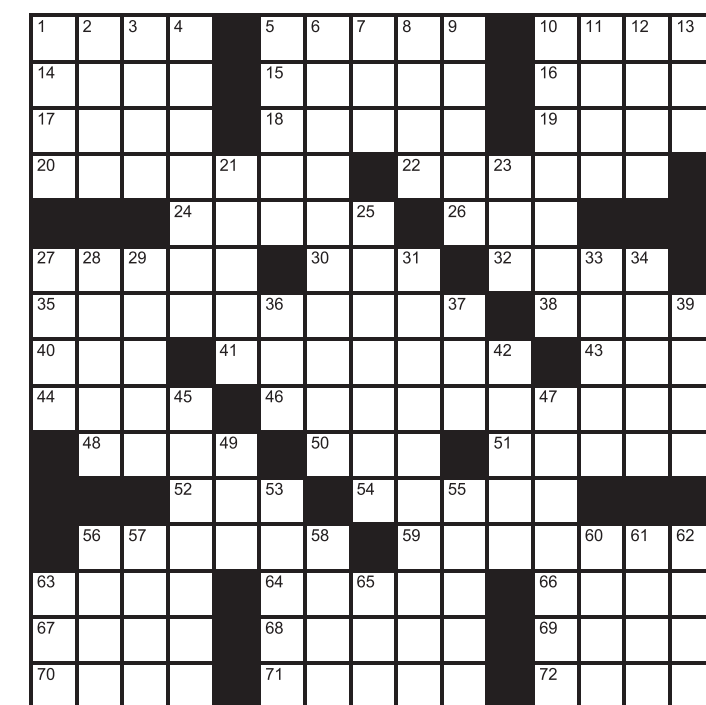

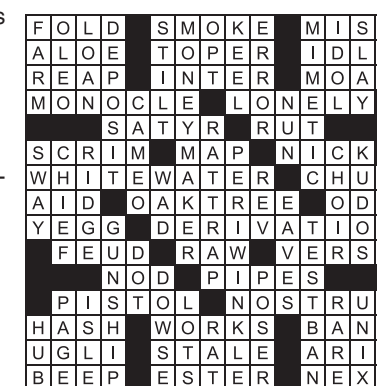
