DPS boosts holiday traffic enforcement

The Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) will increase patrols for an eight-day period that includes both the Christmas and New Year holidays. From Dec. 24 – 27 and Dec. 31 – Jan. 3, DPS troopers, as well as law enforcement, will be patrolling roadways throughout the holiday weekends looking for drunk drivers, speeders, seat belt violators and other drivers who are endangering themselves and others.

“Drinking and driving is always a concern during the holidays, and these DPS patrols help by identifying impaired or reckless drivers who endanger the safety of the traveling public,” said DPS Director Steven McCraw. “We urge Texans to do their part to save lives by always driving sober and adhering to all traffic laws.”

During the Christmas/New Year holiday enforcement effort last year, DPS troopers made 403 DWI arrests. DPS enforcement efforts also resulted in 7,274 speeding citations, 724 seat belt/child safety seat citations, 292 fugitive arrests and 166 felony arrests.

Forest Service says threat of wildfire exists

A wet winter may be in store, but the threat of wildfire still exists.

The current El Niño conditions drop the threat of wildfire to below normal, however Texas A&M Forest Service urges caution this holiday season.

“Fireworks and outdoor fires are usually associated with this time of year,” Jan Amen, fire prevention specialist said. “It's important to be careful, because one spark can cause a devastating fire.”

Although much of the state received above normal rainfall – which suppressed fires for most of the year – the rain increased the amount of grass present, which can serve as fuel for a wildfire start.

“Awareness of this threat is a key safety concern for this winter,” Tom Spencer, Predictive Services department head said.

Abundant fuels can increase fire size and make wildfire more difficult to control.

Spencer also said that even though the ground is wet, the grass above the ground can still catch fire which may spread quickly if conditions are windy.

Texas A&M Forest Service offers the following tips for the holidays:

When and where outdoor burning is allowed, keep the fire small, never leave it unattended and remove leaves and other material from the area surrounding the fire. Avoid lighting piles on windy days.

Keep water, wet towels and a garden hose nearby. A spark or burning ember can ignite dry, fine-textured fuels like grass and weeds.

Properly watering your live Christmas tree and promptly disposing of it after the holidays reduces the chance of a house fire.

Remove your natural Christmas tree soon after the holidays and consider community tree recycling projects.

Dispose of wrapping paper, boxes and other holiday waste by recycling, when practical. Burn paper and cardboard in a burn barrel or fire-proof receptacle topped by a metal screen or grill, as winds can carry embers over long distances.

Stay safe and watch for these new scams

Hi, gang! The IRS Scam is going strong in Donley County. A local lady called and advised she had received two calls in one day. Three short articles this week. Merry Christmas and Happy New Year. Stay safe and watch for scammers.

"Veterans and identity theft Twitter chat" by Carol Kando-Pineda Attorney, FTC's Division of Consumer & Business Education

You probably know a few veterans. You might even be a vet yourself. If so, you'll want to get some valuable tips from the FTC's Military Consumer campaign, the Department of Veteran Affairs and the US Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA). We're joining forces for a Twitter chat about how vets can protect themselves against identity theft and IRS imposter scams - and how to use Identitytheft.gov to recover from this crime.

"Don't recognize that debt? Here's what to do." By Dan Dwyer, Staff Attorney, Division of Financial Practices, FTC

Debt collectors make up to one billion contacts with consumers each year. It's their job to make sure they're collecting from the right people. But sometimes, they reach the wrong person. Other times, they're actually part of a fake debt collection scam.

If you don't recognize a debt, here's what you can do:

Find out who you're dealing with. Ask for the collector's name, the company's name, and its address and phone number. Legitimate collectors will provide this information.

Don't give additional personal information. The collector might ask you to confirm personal information. If the collector has the wrong information, like an address or phone number you've never used, don't correct the mistake with the right information. And don't give any other personal information. If it's not your debt, but the collector now has the right personal information for you, it could be harder for you to dispute the debt later.

Refuse to discuss the debt until you get a "validation notice." Collectors must send you a written notice. It tells you how much money you owe, the name of the creditor, and what to do if you don't think you owe the money. This notice might help you figure out if you owe the debt.

Do your own detective work. Reach out to the company the collector says is the original creditor. They

might help you figure out if the debt is legitimate - and if this collector has the right to collect the debt. Also, get your free, annual credit report online or at 877-322-8228 and see if the debt shows up there.

Dispute the debt in writing. If you think you don't owe some - or all - of the debt, or you just don't recognize it, send the collector a letter disputing it. Be as specific as possible about why you think the debt is wrong - but give as little personal information as possible. Once you get the validation notice, you have 30 days to send this letter.

By law, the collector then must stop contacting you - though the debt doesn't go away. But, if the collector sends you written verification of the debt, they can start contacting you again.

And, if there's incorrect information on your credit report, dispute that, too. You can use these sample letters, using the address given in your credit report.

"Copper clothing to the rescue?" By Amy Hebert, Consumer Education Specialist, FTC

Could what you wear today be the difference between a day of severe pain and one of total relief?

According to Tommie Copper infomercials, TV spots, YouTube videos, print ads, and brochures, wearing the company's copper-

infused compression garments could relieve severe pain and inflammation - whether it's chronic joint pain, or pain caused by diseases like multiple sclerosis, arthritis, and fibromyalgia.

Unfortunately, the FTC says, Tommie Copper and its founder didn't have the science to back up those claims. But that wasn't all. According to the FTC's complaint, Tommie Copper ads also touted the sleeves as "pain relief without a pill." Testimonials claimed that Tommie Copper compression wear was as good as or better than drugs or surgery, with people even claiming to go from needing surgery to "not going near the surgeon's knife" after using Tommie Copper products.

Today, the FTC announced that Tommie Copper and founder Thomas Kallish have agreed to settle the FTC's charges. The order requires the company and Kallish to only make claims they can support with solid scientific research.

Before you try a new health product or service that promises amazing results, talk to your doctor or other healthcare professional. The FTC has brought cases against companies whose ads falsely claimed that a product will treat a serious disease or can replace surgery. To report a health product you believe is advertised falsely, file a complaint with the FTC.

Safety course for hunters to be held at Copper Breaks

QUANAH - Copper Breaks State Park will offer the state-approved Hunter Safety course on Saturday, January 9, 2016, according to Wendell Barberee, lead ranger and Hunter Safety instructor at the park.

The course is required by law for all hunters born after September 2, 1971. Proof of course completion must accompany hunting licenses.

The course begins at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 9, 2015. It is recommended that participants bring a sack lunch as there will only be a short lunch break.

Participation is by reservation only. Younger hunters should be accompanied by an adult. A non-refundable advance payment of \$15.00 is required to sign up for the class. Park admission of \$2.00 for adults is waived for participants, but camping and other fees will apply.

For more information on the Hunter Safety course, other park events or facilities, contact the park daily during business hours at (940)839-4331. Copper Breaks State Park is located 13 miles south of Quanah and eight miles north of Crowell on State Highway 6.

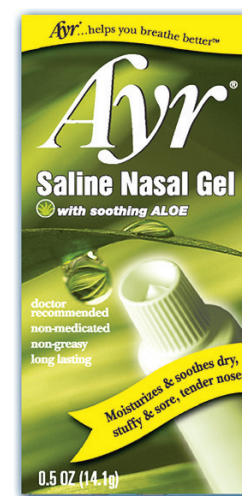

House passes budget and tax bills

WASHINGTON - U.S. Congressman Mac Thornberry (R-Clarendon) voted this week in support of the "Protecting Americans from Tax Hikes (PATH) Act of 2015" that passed the House by vote of 318-109 and the "Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016" that passed by a vote of 316-113.

"There are a number of good and important provisions for the country and for our area in these bills," said Thornberry. "While there are also a number of provisions that I support - and have voted for - that did not survive negotiations, many did."

Some of the chief provisions

include:

Providing essential funding for our military; Repealing the 40-year-old ban on exporting crude oil; Limiting EPA funding to its lowest level since 2008; Repealing the Country-of-Origin-Labeling (COOL) law that threatened to harm the beef and other livestock industries; Extending and then phasing out the wind production tax credit; Delaying implementation of several provisions and taxes associated with Obamacare; and Strengthening security of the Visa Waiver Program.

The PATH bill also made permanent over 20 tax provisions that Congress has been extending one

year at a time, making it difficult for businesses and individuals to plan. These permanent deductions include: State and local sales tax deduction, which is important in states like Texas that do not have a state income tax; Section 179 expensing for small businesses; The Research and Development Tax Credit; Charitable deduction for contributions of food inventory; and Many other tax provisions were extended for two or five years.

Finally, attached to the measure is a cybersecurity bill, similar to that recommended by the Cyber Security Task Force, which Thornberry chaired in 2011 and 2012.

Texas checkoff program begins its second year

AUSTIN - After a successful inaugural year, the Texas state beef checkoff program began its second year of collections that fund programs aimed at strengthening and expanding beef demand.

Texas beef producers voted in June 2014 to establish a state-level beef checkoff program, which was approved by a wide margin of 66 percent of voters. The Texas Department of Agriculture conducted the referendum upon petition by cattle industry organizations under the authorities designated by the Texas Legislature.

The program is funded through a refundable \$1 per head assessment on cattle at each point of ownership transfer in Texas. The funds are managed in accordance with Texas law by the Beef Promotion Research Council of Texas (BPRCT). The BPRCT consists of 20 Texas cattle producers appointed by the Texas commissioner of agriculture.

The BPRCT contracts with the Texas Beef Council to conduct demand-building programs in the areas of promotion, research and education. The fiscal 2016 year began Oct. 1, 2015 for the BPRCT with a budget of \$9.51 million.

Nasal Spray Reverses Medicine Overdose
The United States Food and Drug Administration recently approved a nasal spray formulation of a medication that has been used for some time to reverse overdose events related to certain pain medications. The spray contains naloxone, it is called Narcan. It reverses the effects of an overdose from opioid medications such as morphine, hydrocodone, and oxy-codone. The nasal spray version of naloxone hydrochloride (Narcan) is believed to immediately help deliver the medication safely in life-threatening situations. In clinical trial naloxone nasal spray was delivered into one nostril. It produced the same level of overdose reversal compared to the injectable medication. Narcan nasal spray can cause symptoms of withdrawal when it is administered to people with opioid dependence. Signs of withdrawal include body aches, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, restlessness, shivering, and increased blood pressure.

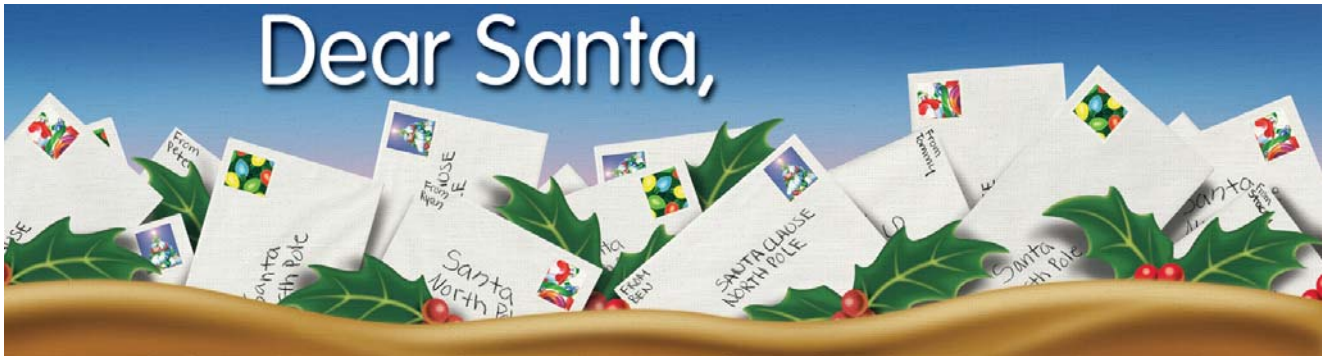

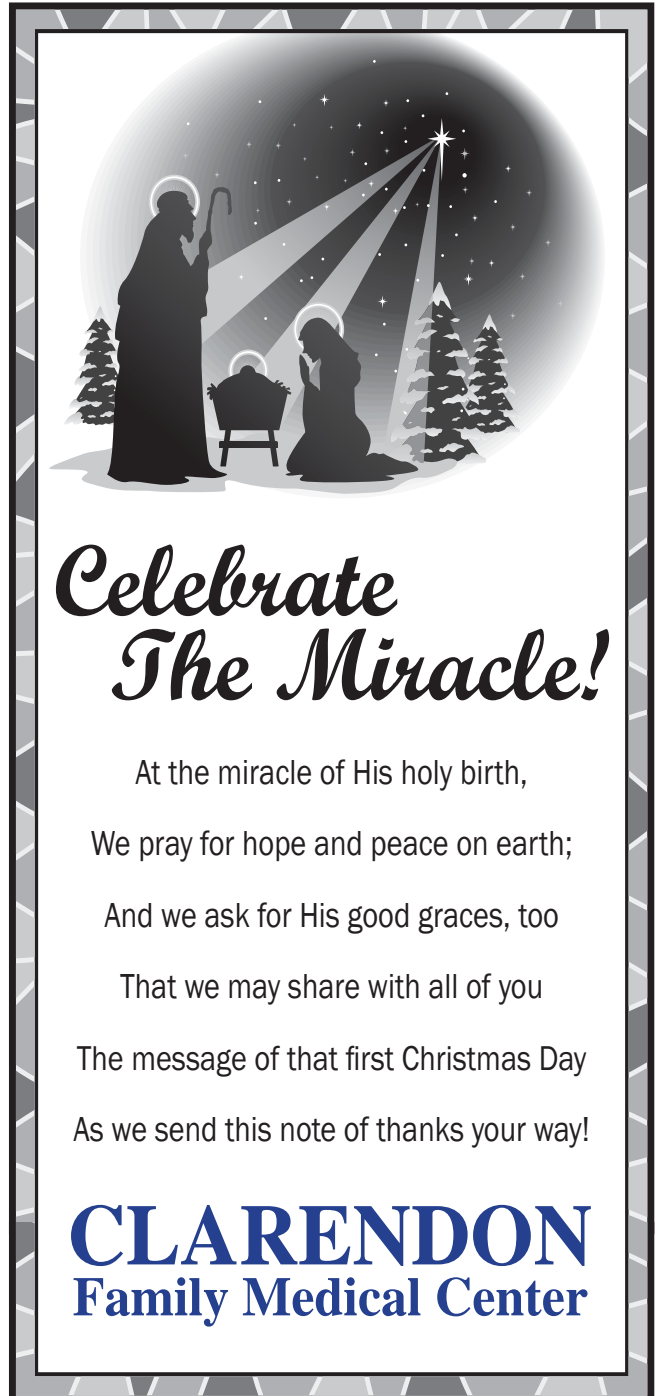
