### How To Keep A Living Legacy For The Deceased

You can honor the memory of loved one who has passed on, and help needy, deserving WTC students, at the same time. Carefully consider the two options listed below.

#### Endowed Scholarship

Currently, WTC has over 1.1 million dollars invested in endowed scholarships, from which the interest is utilized to assist students in paying for their education here at WTC. Because of our significant increase in student numbers this year and based on projected growth to 2000 within the next five years, our next goal is to raise that amount to 2 million dollars. Our philosophy is that no student that applies for a scholarship, and meets the necessary criteria, will be refused.

A significant portion of these funds were given and named in the memory of a family member or friend. Named scholarships are established with a gift of \$5000 with the donor establishing criteria and naming the scholarship. A gift of \$5,000 begins the process and can be given in one of two ways: (1) In one lump sum; or (2) In increments over a period of time until the amount is built up to \$5,000 or more.

Contributions to a scholarship fund can be of any amount. Donations in honor or memory of an individual are acknowledged with a receipt to the donor and an acknowledgement to the recipient requested by the donor.

#### Memorial Brick or Granite Marker in WTC's Walk of Honor

For only \$100 a brick, or \$300 for a larger granite marker, you can permanently place the name of that special person for viewing, while at the same time contributing to WTC into a flexible fund that will be utilized to build endowment, fund special projects and programs, or towards scholarships, all as needed.

## Western Texas College Walk of Honor

Your name or that of someone important to you can be inscribed to become a permanent part of the Walk of Honor at WTC. Bricks and granite markers will pave an area on either side of the south walkway leading into the heart of the campus.

In the Walk of Honor, personalized granite markers and bricks will be permanently set to honor those who are close to your heart or who have been so valuable to your growth. These could be parents, grandparents, children, a spouse, a whole family, a professor or some other member of the WTC family, a specific department or team sport at WTC, a friend or some other loved one, or a particular year and graduating class from WTC. You could give honor a particular organization, social club or civic group.

We hope that the Walk of Honor will become a tradition at every graduation and also for every special occasion such as a birthday, anniversary or holiday. Each brick and marker is an investment in WTC that will be utilized for endowment, scholarships or to "seed" future development that will continue to fund Western Texas College's ever expanding role in the community.

Please fill in the blocks with the letters exactly as you want them to appear on your brick. Granite markers contain available space for 20 characters per line and up to eight lines per marker. Organizational logos, coat of arms or symbol may be engraved the marker for an additional \$25 setup fee. For bricks, there is space available for 14 characters per line and three lines per brick. On both the granite markers and bricks, there is only one character (letter, number, space) is allowed per block. Leave a space between names, and before and after "&". Limit one name per brick (except for husband and wife). Minor changes may be required to conform to engraver limitations and standardization procedures. Lines will be centered for you. Please place information for additional markers or bricks on a separate sheet of paper. Brick orders received together will be laid together.
