

Water the plant when the soil surface feels dry to a light touch. It's very important not to allow your plant to sit in standing water.

• It is not necessary to fertilize your poinsettias when they are in bloom. However, after the holidays, a balanced, all-purpose household plant fertilizer will help maintain the rich, green foliage color and promote new growth.

When He was dead, He was taken down and laid in a borrowed grave through the pily of a friend.

Ninoteen centuries have come and gone, and today He is the central figure for much of the human race. All the armies that ever marched, and all the navies that ever sailed, and all the parliaments that ever sat, and all the kings that ever reigned, put logether, have not affected the life of man upon this earth as powerfully as this "One Politary Life."

Although this poem has become popular in recent years, it is not a contemporary piece. The poem actually has tracings back to medieval times, and the poet to this day remains anonymous.






