### 'Buck Fever' Applies At Least Two Ways

Have you ever heard of "buck fever?" Chances are you have, if you have ever hunted — or listened to hunting tales, as most Texans have.

Few hunters — or deer, for that matter — ever die as a result of buck fever. This so-called fever or disease usually occurs when a hunter spots a deer and loses his head instead of being calm.

But over a hundred died last year and will this year from a symptom of this disease — light-headedness — although it is labeled "hunting accidents" in the books.

For example, who would ever climb up an unfamiliar tree in the dark, carrying a loaded gun — except on the first morning of deer season?

Who would ever put a loaded gun in the hands of an untrained teenager and turn him loose in the woods — except during deer season?

Or who would ever snake his way through a barbed wire fence wagging a loaded rifle behind him — except during deer season?

And when would you ever choose a loaded rifle for a companion around the campfire or over a hot cup of coffee — except during a hunting excursion?

Planning, preparedness and thoughtfulness would eliminate many unnecessary hunting fatalities. Unloading your rifle before you climb a tree or go through a fence takes a few seconds — maybe even a minute — but why gamble a minute against your life?

If your youngster wants to hunt, prepare him before you

To those hunters who were fortunate enough to bag a deer this year, let me give you one way to utilize some of the meat. Venison sausage is delicious and here is a suggested recipe: 30 pounds cut venison, 20 pounds cut fat pork—about 50-60 per cent lean, 1 pound salt, 3 ounces black pepper, 2 ounces sage, optional, 1 ounce red pepper, optional; your favorite sausage seasoning may be used instead of the above.

Sprinkle the seasonings over the meat and grind. If the sausage is to be frozen, season only half the total amount. Seasoned sausage can be thawed and cooked immediately while the unseasoned portion should receive seasoning just before using. Unseasoned sausage will keep fresh 5-6 months in storage.

take him out. Teach him gun-handling techniques and safety, or check in your community for gun-handling courses.

When you take time out from your hunting for coffee, a nap or supper, unload your gun. A loaded gun is a dangerous companion.

A cardinal rule for hunters of any kind and at any time is to make sure you know what you are shooting. Almost every year the headlines tell about someone who was mistaken and shot for a turkey, deer or game of some sort.

Buck fever is nothing to be ashamed of, but carelessness is. When you load your rifle this season — or any time, for that matter — leave your light-headedness behind.

### Law Limits Boat Usage For Ducks

Some "small print" instructions governing the harvesting of migratory game were pointed out by J. B. Phillips, law enforcement coordinator for the Parks and Wildlife Department, since the duck season opens in Texas November 25.

The rules, which also apply to goose hunting which began in Texas Oct. 31, stipulate that:

"Waterfowl may be taken from outboard motor boat if boat is beached, resting at anchor, or is placed inside of or secured to any shooting blind. Motor boat, sailboat, or other craft may be used solely as a means of picking up dead or injured birds.

"The use of aircraft, power boats, sailboats, or other floating craft or device of any kind for purpose of concentrating, driving, rallying or stirring up waterfowl and coots is strictly prohibited. The use of recorded or electrically amplified bird calls or sound is prohibited."
