Some phases of the Governor's program require clarification, however. First, the idea o
rewarding teachers with experience more than be

has held to this principle for many years From 1943 to 1953 the minimum salary. for Texa
teachers was increased $\$ 1,500$ while the maximum (for more experience) went up $\$ 3,000$ averaging
about $\$ 2,200$. And in the $1953-63$ period the begin
ning neat galary was raised $\$ 1,600$ while the experienced
teacher at the maximum was raised average of the meriod was approximately $\$ 1,800$
This would compare with the average eraise of $\$ 900$
