## Medicare Doctors/Suppliers List Now Available To Area Elderly

People with Medicare can now get an idea of which
doctors and suppliers in the local area have accepted assignment of medical
insurance claims. Each medicare carrier publishes a Physician /Supplier Assignment Rate List for the area it serves. All carrier's service area in the a copy of the list for people to use as a reference source.
Medicare carriers are the insurance organizations sel-
ected by the Government to ected by the Government to
handle claims under th medical insurance part Medicar
The list shows the name, ddress, and assignment rate of each doctor and supplier in the preceding calendar year.
Names are listed in alphabetical order. The assignment rate is shown in a range of 10 percentage points -that is, 100 percent. If a doctor prac tices as part of a group, the
group name and assignment rate are shown.
