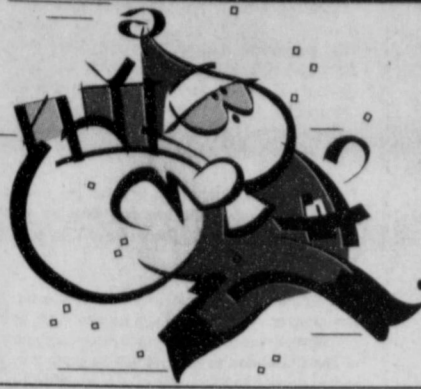

Vargas files to run for re-election as clerk

Democrat Fay Vargas has filed for re-election as County/District Clerk, joining County Judge Jack Hall and Justice of the Peace for Precincts 3&4 Ann Kennedy on the Democratic primary ballot.

The Republican primary line up includes US Rep. Mac Thornberry, County Treasurer Wanda Smith, Pct. 2 County Commissioner Donnie Hall, and Landon Paul Lambert, who has filed to run for county attorney.

Other local positions up for election next year include commissioner of Precinct 4, and justice of the peace for Precincts 1 & 2.

The Republican ballot will also include county chairman Tom Stauder and precinct chairmen Betty Hester, Jo Webb, Helen Land, Ron Lamberth, Bill Carson, and Ginger Stone. Stauder says he will be at the county clerk's office January 2 between 5 and 6 p.m. for any person wishing to file for the Republican Primary at that time, or interested persons can call him at 874-5099 before then.

Filing for both the Democratic and Republican primaries continues in the clerk's office through 6 p.m. January 2, 2006. Those seeking public office will be required to pay a \$750 filing fee or can present a petition to waive the fee. The primary elections will be held March 7, 2006.

New team brings old values to Suna AutoMall

Trust and friendship are two things that cannot be bought, and the new management team at Suna AutoMall says they intend to earn both from customers in Clarendon and the surrounding area.

The General Motors dealership has begun a management contract that will culminate with the sale of the business to Stanley Automotive Enterprises on or about February 1, 2006.

The priority of the business will be serving local people with old-fashioned values, and that's something of a tradition for area manager Don Crow.

"I learned integrity from my father and grandfather," Crow said.

"You look people in the eye, shake their hand, and tell them the truth."

Crow's grandfather started selling cars in Abernathy in 1927. Now, as the third generation in his family of car dealers, Crow says his West Texas roots guide his business philosophy.

"You do what you say and a little bit more," he said. "You just treat everybody the way you'd want your own mother treated."

The Stanley group has big plans for the dealership, which was founded in 1956 by Fred E. Chamberlain, Jr., and operated as Chamberlain Motor Company until August 2002, when it was purchased by New York native Mark Suna, who has since moved to

Kentucky.

Customers can expect to see more cars on the lot in the next 60 to 90 days as the Stanley group builds up the dealership's inventory, Crow said.

"I'd like to see us have 75 to 100 new cars and 65 to 80 used cars."

In addition to a larger inventory, Crow says the Stanley group intends to completely renovate the dealership to make it a more functional facility that will be customer friendly. Plans for the showroom are still being finalized but will likely include new flooring, replacing the ceiling tiles, and going through the air-conditioning and electrical systems.

HHS senior breaks neck in car wreck

A Hedley High School senior remains hospitalized this week after being seriously injured in a one-vehicle rollover December 14.

Britney Upton, age 18, was traveling south on FM 1547 between Memphis and Quail when the accident occurred, according to Department of Public Safety spokesman Daniel Hawthorn. For an unknown reason, the young woman lost control of her black Chevy S10 pickup, over-corrected, rolled multiple times, and was ejected and thrown through a barbed wire fence.

She was not wearing her safety belt. Wellington EMS responded to the accident and transported Upton to Hedley, where she was airlifted to North West Texas Hospital in Amarillo. She was later medivaced to University Medical Center in Lubbock for additional treatment.

Upton is the daughter of Tim and Jackie Upton of Memphis. The family is giving regular updates to Hedley ISD instructor and Enterprise photographer Kari Lindsey, who is in turn posting that information on the school's Web site at www.hedleyisd.net.

According to the family, Upton

suffered six broken vertebrae, a fracture to her right collarbone, and multiple fractures in her right foot. Her right lung was also injured.

She is reported to be doing remarkably well, and she ate her first solid meal Monday.

This accident was especially alarming for the Upton family because Britney lost a younger brother in a rollover near Claude about ten years ago, Lindsey said.

DPS officials remind everyone to buckle their seatbelts to prevent injuries like those Upton received last week.

"Statistics tell us that 80 percent of rollover victims in light trucks who were wearing safety belts escape with only minor injuries," Hawthorn said. "The stats speak for themselves. Buckle up."

A fund has been established at Memphis State Bank to help with the Upton family with expenses as they take off work and travel to Lubbock to be with their daughter.

Aldermen approve zoning amendment

Clarendon Aldermen approved a change in residential zoning December 13 despite one citizen's protest.

The board enacted Ordinance 360, which amends zoning regulations in the R1 and R2 districts to allow state licensed physical therapy facilities.

The issue first came before the city when Larry Hicks addressed the board's November 8 meeting and said he would like to rent his property at 507 E. Fourth to a physical therapist. The board voted to make the zoning change and approved the first reading of Ordinance 360 at the city's November 22 meeting.

During a public hearing before last Tuesday's vote, Robert Paul, who lives in the same neighborhood, spoke out against the new ordinance.

"It's next to my property, and I don't think it should be there," Paul said.

Mayor Tex Selvidge asked if Paul had any particular objection to a physical therapy business being nearby, such as parking or other concern. Paul indicated that he just didn't want it there when other property in town was available.

Other citizens present expressed no concern about the issue.

The board unanimously approved the new ordinance, and Paul left the room speaking under his breath. Selvidge asked if the man had something else to say. To which he responded, "Looks like there wasn't much to it. Looks like you made your mind up before the hearing."

In other city business, the board approved \$1,500 from the Motel Bed Tax fund to promote the Greenbelt Holiday Tournament to be held at Clarendon High School and Clarendon College on December 29 - 31.

The board approved a letter to the Office of Rural Community Affairs requesting a site visit for a potential STEP grant application. The project would replace certain water mains and sewer lines in the city.

City employees John Molder and LeAnn Marcum addressed the board regarding discrepancies in the policy manual regarding paid holidays. After some discussion, the board agreed that the manual calls for three paid days off at Christmas and set those dates this year as Friday, December 23, and Monday and Tuesday, December 26 and 27.

The board will revise and clarify the

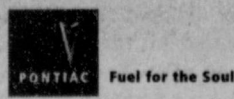
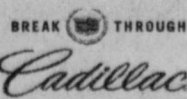

In the service department, air-conditioning will be installed and state of the art diagnostic equipment will be added.

"We're going to make sure that we have all the equipment we need to serve our customers the proper way," Crow said.

Under the new management for only a short time, new life has been breathed into the dealership with sales picking up, and new employees being hired, and old employees are returning.

"We're leading our district in terms of performance, which indicates that [general manager] Ken

[Sisk] is doing a great job," Crow said. "Terry Noble is back in the shop and doing great work, Master Tech Matt Chambers is all set up, and we've hired a couple of salesmen."

The Suna AutoMall staff also consists of comptroller Connie Simpson, title clerk Nancy Kidd, sales manager Rod Darris, service manager Eddie Bartley, receptionist Tessie Robinson, and salesman Jerry Daniels.

Crow is splitting his time between Suna AutoMall and Childress Ford in Childress, which is also under a management contract with Stanley. He and his wife, Donna, will

make their home in this area as soon as they sell their house in Driftwood, near Austin.

In addition to Suna AutoMall and Childress Ford, the Stanley group owns 15 dealerships in rural communities and is looking at adding others. Crow says there are benefits to being in such a large group.

"We're able to sell out of each other's inventories; so if we don't have the car you're looking for, we can find it immediately and have it here usually within 24 hours," Crow said.

manual some time next year.

Dave Stout addressed the board and requested that potholes on Front Street and N. Carhart Street be filled. City Superintendent Jim Roberts said he would see if he could get this done.

City engineer Che Shadle answered questions from the board about the progress of the street project. Alderman Tommy Hill inquired about density requirements for the base material on Sixth Street, and Shadle said the street meets specifications.

Hill asked about oil coming up on Sixth, and Shadle said the oil is there to protect the base from wet weather. The reason it came up in

some areas is that some citizens moved cones out of the intersections and drove on the street while work was underway.

Alderman Janice Knorpp asked about why some streets, particularly Eighth Street, looks like a zig zag. Shadle said it was either that or tear up more yards or move people's trees.

"They [the streets] are not laid out by idiots; they just have to dodge things," he said. "If you don't do that, you have to screw up a lot of other things."

The board approved hiring Scott Landis for the gatehouse at the recycling center and Stormy Mayberry for the street department.

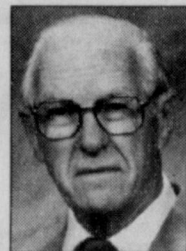

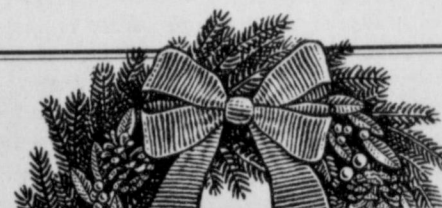

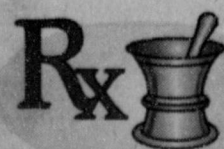

CC Regents hold regular meeting

The Clarendon College Board of Regents met in regular session December 15 in the VIP Room of the Bairfield Activity Center.

Among the items on the board's agenda, regents accepted the 2005 fiscal audit as presented by Fox, Byrd & Co.

The board awarded three bids related to vocational nursing equipment, including Lateral Medical for \$19,427, Pocket Nurse for \$1,737, and Thompson Learning for \$1,200.

The sale of delinquent properties in Howardwick and Hedley was approved as presented by the Donley County Appraisal District.

A new policy on academic integrity was accepted as prepared by the faculty, staff, and administration.

The board approved a grant application to the Chapman Foundation to purchase trees to be placed near the Alumni Courtyard and the Vera Dial Dickey Library. A decision on the application is expected next month.

Preliminary drawings for renovating the old CC library into administrative offices were presented. Architects will now prepare detailed drawings.

The board accepted the resignation of Judy Green as a secretary at the CC Pampa Center and approved hiring Wayne Price to teach desktop publishing in the Roach Unit at Childress and Jennifer Black and Peggy Stewart as vocational nursing instructors.

Thornberry votes to strengthen border

WASHINGTON, DC - In the continuing effort to reduce our country's vulnerability to terrorism, the U.S. House of Representatives this week acted to tighten control of our nation's borders. By a vote of 239-182, the House approved H.R. 4437, the "Border Protection, Antiterrorism, and Illegal Immigration Control Act of 2005."

Congressman Mac Thornberry (R-Clarendon), who voted in favor of the bill, said failure to secure our borders "makes it nearly impossible to defend our nation against terrorist attacks."

"We are a nation of immigrants," said Thornberry. "We must continue to welcome people who want to

come here to share their talents. But, our nation will never be safe until we control who and what crosses our borders."

To establish better control of the nation's borders and ports, H.R. 4437 calls on the Department of Homeland Security to:

- Enhance surveillance of international land and maritime borders through more effective use of unmanned aerial vehicles, ground-based sensors, satellites, radar coverage, and cameras.

- Hire and train as quickly as possible the additional 10,000 Border Patrol agents authorized under the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004. (Under

current plans, approximately 1,500 additional agents are scheduled to be hired during this fiscal year.)

- Increase by not less than 1,000 the number of full-time port of entry inspectors by the end of Fiscal Year 2010.

- Train an additional 1,500 canine detection teams over the next five years.

- Deploy radiation portal monitors at U.S. ports of entry and facilities to screen inbound cargo for nuclear and radiological material.

Thornberry said a key element of the bill is the elimination of a practice known as "catch and release." Under current policy, illegal aliens from countries other than Mexico are often

released due to a lack of detention space. More than 100,000 illegal aliens have been released under such circumstances this year.

H.R. 4437 will require the detention of all illegal immigrants apprehended at U.S. land borders. All illegal aliens caught at U.S. borders will have to remain in custody until they are removed from the country. The bill also calls upon the Department of Homeland Security to make full use of all detention facilities it currently operates or contracts and to pursue options including paying to use state and local correctional facilities.

H.R. 4437 will now be sent to the U.S. Senate.

USDA-NRCS seeks EQIP applications

USDA cost-share funds have been released for the 2006 Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP). Farmers and ranchers can apply for Farm Bill conservation programs through the USDA-Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) to make sound decisions regarding conservation practices before planting season begins.

Eligible producers may apply for cost share assistance on conservation practices that will address the identified resource concern recognized by the Local Work Group (LWG).

Practices are implemented through EQIP offering cost share assistance to agricultural producers to implement on-farm conservation practices. The NRCS determines eligible land and eligible conservation practices.

The Clarendon USDA Service Center will be accepting EQIP applications for 2006. The deadline for applications on 2006 EQIP funding is February 17, 2006. For information call (806) 874-3561, x3.
