A system for tagging bobcat approved and Texas has been the Teras Parks and Wildife Commission as authorized by Che Texas laws on non-game
animals and the federal Endangered Species Scientific Asantion. The ESSA program allows
Texas to tag an unlimited number of bobcat pelts during
the 1978.79 season which runs her Nov, 15,1978 through Feb.
