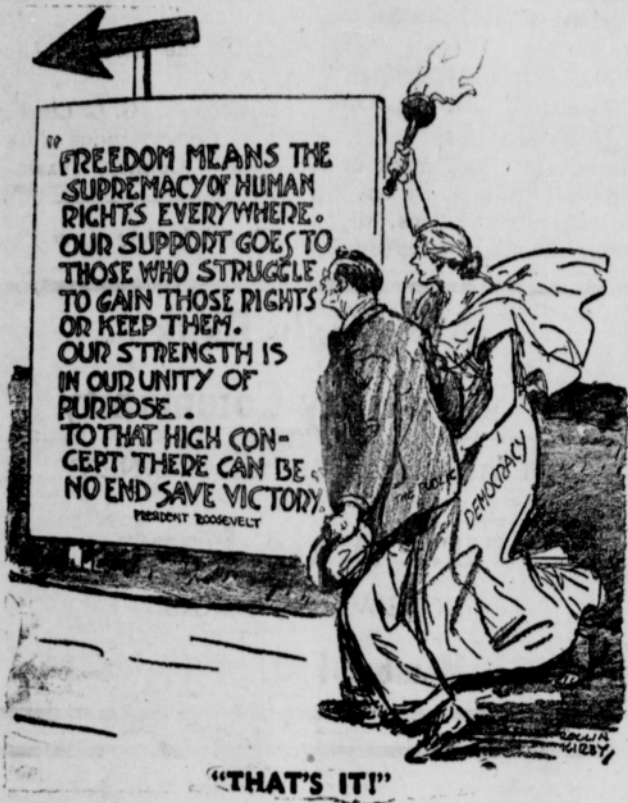

The County Draft Board has released information that all men who have become 21 years of age since Oct. 16, 1940 will be required to report at the Court House in Brownfield to register in response to a proclamation issued by the President of the United States, said registration to be on July 1, 1941.

Those from Prec. 1 will go to the County Clerk's office; Prec. 2 to the Tax Collector's office; Prec. 3 in the County Judge's office, and Prec. 4 in the office of the county Supt.

Notice To Taxpayers!

A new law, House Bill No. 86, passed recently by the Legislature, and duly signed by the Governor, and now in effect, RELEASES INTEREST AS WELL AS PART OF THE PENALTY ON STATE AND COUNTY TAXES, which were delinquent on or before July 1, 1940. The bill was approved May 22, 1941, and became effective when signed by the Governor on May 26.

This is to advise that if you have any delinquent taxes, either state or county, or both, YOU MAY TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS NEW REMISSION LAW NOW by paying ALL of your taxes which are delinquent. For instance, if you have TWO or MORE years delinquent taxes ALL must be paid, to get the benefit of this new law. The law and remission offer will expire on November 1, (this year) 1941. Please be sure to bear in mind that this law DOES NOT AFFECT 1940 TAXES, and on these the usual Penalty will be collected for delinquent taxes for the year 1940.

As an example, and to show and illustrate your savings under this new law--suppose a person has delinquent taxes for two years, as follows:

Year	Amount	Usual Penalty	Present Penalty	Savings
1934	\$100.00	44 p.c.--\$44.00	6 p.c.--\$6.00	\$38.00
1938	\$100.00	20 p.c.--\$20.00	6 p.c.--\$6.00	\$14.00

Penalties that are usual and would customarily be collected (before this law was passed) were: 1934 and all prior years, 44 per cent; 1935-38 per cent; 1936-32 per cent; 1937-26 per cent; 1938-20 per cent; 1939-16 per cent. Under the new penalty remission law, only 6 per cent interest is now to be collected, if paid prior to Nov. 1, 1941, for each year. The penalties are remitted.

All 1940 state and county taxes carry the usual penalty, which at this time amounts to 7 1-2 per cent, and on July 1, 1941, a penalty of 10 1-2 per cent will be due on all delinquent 1940 taxes.

PLEASE NOTE -- That you MUST PAY ALL years taxes delinquent and that they must be paid before November 1, 1941 to get the benefit of the above discount. If not fully clear, or for further information see your county Tax Collector at Brownfield, Texas.

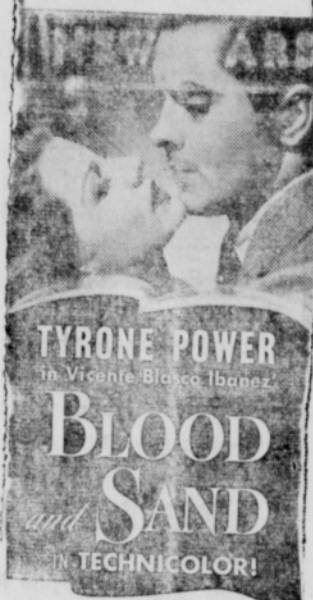
