It was through recognition of this fact that our Democratic form of Government found its origin, thus according equal rights to all, with special privileges towards none," with the intention of its laws based on the principle, that whatever law a marjority of the people said the country should be governed by, opposition was to submissively submit and be ruled accordingly. One of the new laws makes it illegal for any person firm or corporation to deliver to any other person any intoxicating few things he is not up on now. liquor for shipment into Local Option territory. It is also unlawful to transport or carry liquors into districts where its sale is prohibited and another restriction makes it unlawful for for anyone to recive such liquor.

In other words, the only way a person can got an intoxicant in a local option district is to carry it on his person. He is barred under the law from offering drink to another or cermitting any one else to take a drink with him. 
