help prevent illiness or speed a person's recovery from an titness.
For ex mple, honiemaker services may help eldprly pe ople continue to live independently and can assure
that medicines are taken on time and that proper nutrthat medicines are taken on lime and that proper nutri
tion is maintained, In addition, inany elderly people would benefll from custodial care that helped them meet their personal care needs. The question is: Given the fact that only limited funds are available, how may
they best be spent? they best be spent? supportive in nature and which can be furnished by supportive in nature and which can be furnished by vices may include help with bathing. dressing, and eating.
Custodial care may be covered under Medicare If it
is part of the medically necessary care being provided is part of the medicaily necessary care being provided
a patient. A person who is convalescing in a skilled nursing lacility, for example, is covered for the custodial care that is an inseparable part of the treat-
ment. However, custodial care thai is not an integral ment. Howevet, custodial care that is not an integral
part of medical care, such os participation in meals-on. wheels, is nol ;eimbursable.
Medicare is designed to meet the most jressing health care needs, which private insurance ordinarily does not cover: it cannot bleet all health care needs. 9. My father is a pationt in a skilled nursing facility.
Does that mean that any custodial services he recielves will be covered by Medicare?
A. Not mecensarilly. The kifind of serviees being furnished deteravines Whether they are covered, mot the place where they are beling furmished. Q. My mother cannot be relled on tc take her
medioine when she should. Isn't this considered imp portant enough to ba covered by Medicare?
A. Taking medication on schedule is extremely important. However, vinco asnisting a person te take his or her
medieine is a custoalial service, it is not covared under Medicare.
