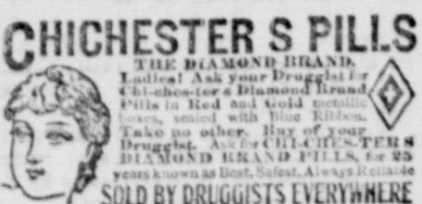

TO OPEN INCOME TAX OFFICE HERE

C. R. Stephens and W. R. Bruce are arranging to open an office in Ballinger for the purpose of serving the public in handling income tax reports. They expect to be ready to open their office within a couple of weeks.

"We have been studying the question thoroughly," said Mr. Bruce, "and we are going to spend some time with the income tax collectors and learn every detail of the work, and will open our office as soon as possible."

Under the law governing the payment of income tax, all parties are required to file a report regardless of whether they are subject to the payment of a tax or not, and the demand for the services of some one familiar with making out reports will be great here.

The year has been a prosperous one, and it is expected that many citizens will have to pay income tax this year.
