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CAPITOL JIGSAW

AUSTIN, June 7 (AP)—Gov. James V. Allred says there is an unwritten law which he does not intend to violate.

It is, he told press correspondents, that the governor must not interfere with affairs of the University of Texas.

"I am very sensitive to it," he commented.

At the same time, he said he hoped the regents would choose an "outstanding educator" to head the institution on the place of the late Dr. H. Y. Benedict.

"I favor getting a good man," he said, "and paying him a good salary."

Under last-minute action at the general session of the legislature, the regents were authorized to pay the president \$17,500 a year. Dr. Benedict received \$8,000.

Gov. Allred said he would not veto the salary item.

Although the measure failed to pass the House at the recent general session, Rep. J. Bryan Bradbury of Abilene may introduce in the future a bill which would raise the minimum age which girl may marry in Texas.

The present law provides minimum requirements for males of 16 years and for females of 14, and even at those ages consent of parents must be obtained. To marry without such consent, the male must be at least 21 and the female 18.

Bradbury's bill, which died on the House calendar after being passed to engrossment, would have raised the minimum for females to 16 and left that for the male unchanged.

"It seems there is an increasing tendency to marry while very young," he said. "Girls at 14 are neither physically nor mentally ready for marriage."

The journals of House and Senate for the last day were the largest of any for the general session. The Senate Journal totaled 211 pages and the House 372.

The reason was they contained copies of the education, departmental, and rural aid appropriation bills as well as the new liquor control and other important measures.

Because of the weight, Senator Grady Woodruff of Decatur sought to have the mailing list curtailed. Cost of mailing each journal would be about 10 cents, he estimated.

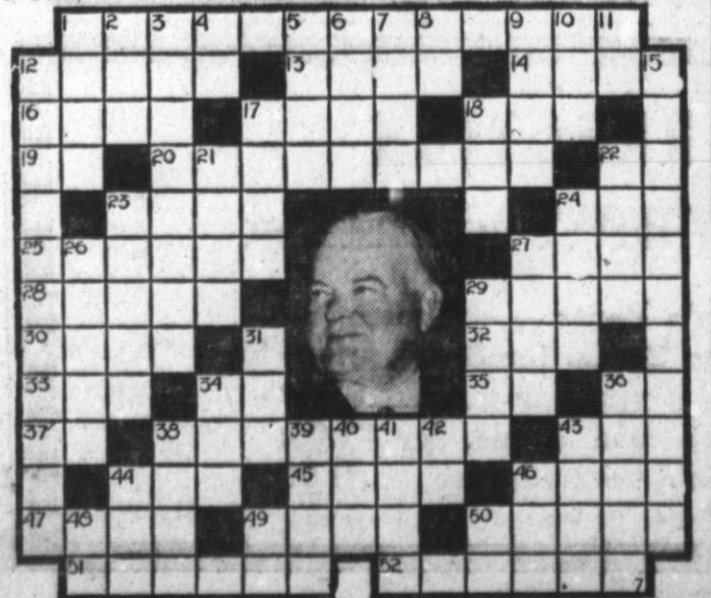

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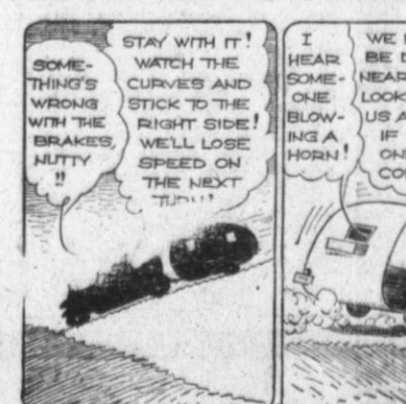
