Football Contest Is Underway This Week

Coach Monte Barnes is expecting the Owls to run variations of the Power I formation on offense and a 4-4-3 defense. According to Barnes the Owls have a good offense and two good, big, running backs. Their quarterback does not pass very often, but when he does, he can be very effective.

The Mustangs scrimmaged the Friona Chieftains last Friday and

Coach Barnes said, "I was impressed by the way we hit." The Mustangs were outscored 3-1 in the scrimmage, but the coaches were pleased with the effort since most of the players were trying out new positions.

The Mustangs have very few injuries going into their season opener, but they did suffer the loss of their starting fullback and linebacker when Doug Roming was lost for the season with a knee injury.

Game time will be 8 p.m., and the game will be at the Hale Center football field.

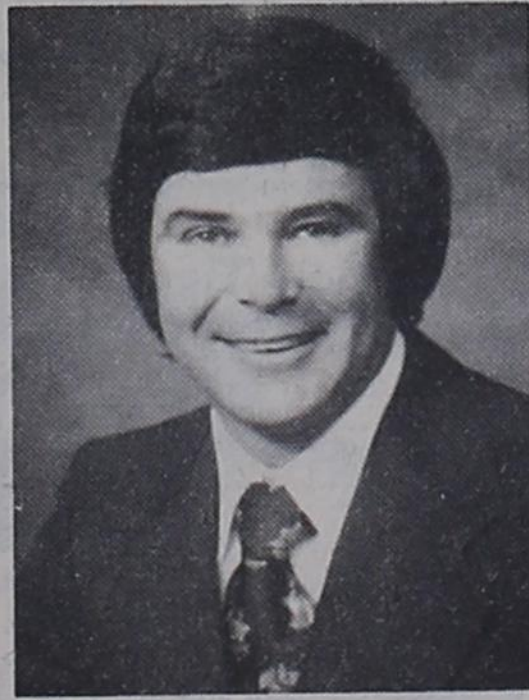
School Totals Down Slightly

According to Bovina School officials, the total enrollment for the opening day is down from last year's figures. Total enrollment for this year is 511, compared to 542 for last year.

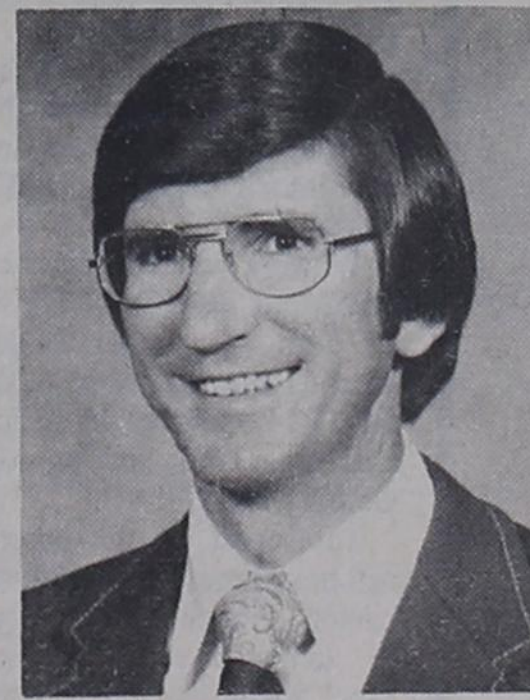

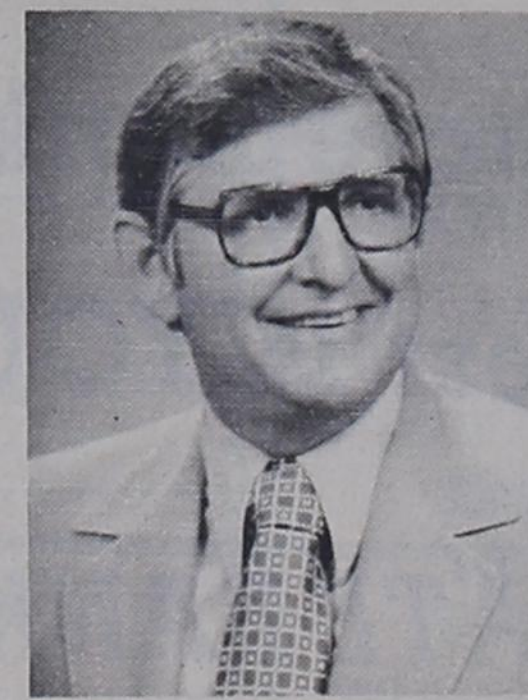

EMS Sets Course

The Bovina Ambulance Service and the Panhandle Emergency Medical Service have slated an Emergency Care Attendant (ECA) course in Bovina.

The ECA course consists of 30 hours of classroom instruction plus testing by PEMS. Each student upon passing the exam will be issued a certificate (ECA) recognized by the Texas Emergency Medical Services.

The course is designed to help the layman understand and cope with emergency medical crisis. The course also lays the groundwork for advanced medical courses.

The Bovina course will be instructed by members of the Bovina Ambulance Service and Mark Pallady, EMT from Farwell.

Tentative time and dates of classroom instruction are 8-11 p.m., September 24-25-27; 8-11 p.m. October 1-2-5-8-13-14; October 15-16 for makeups and testing on October 18-22.

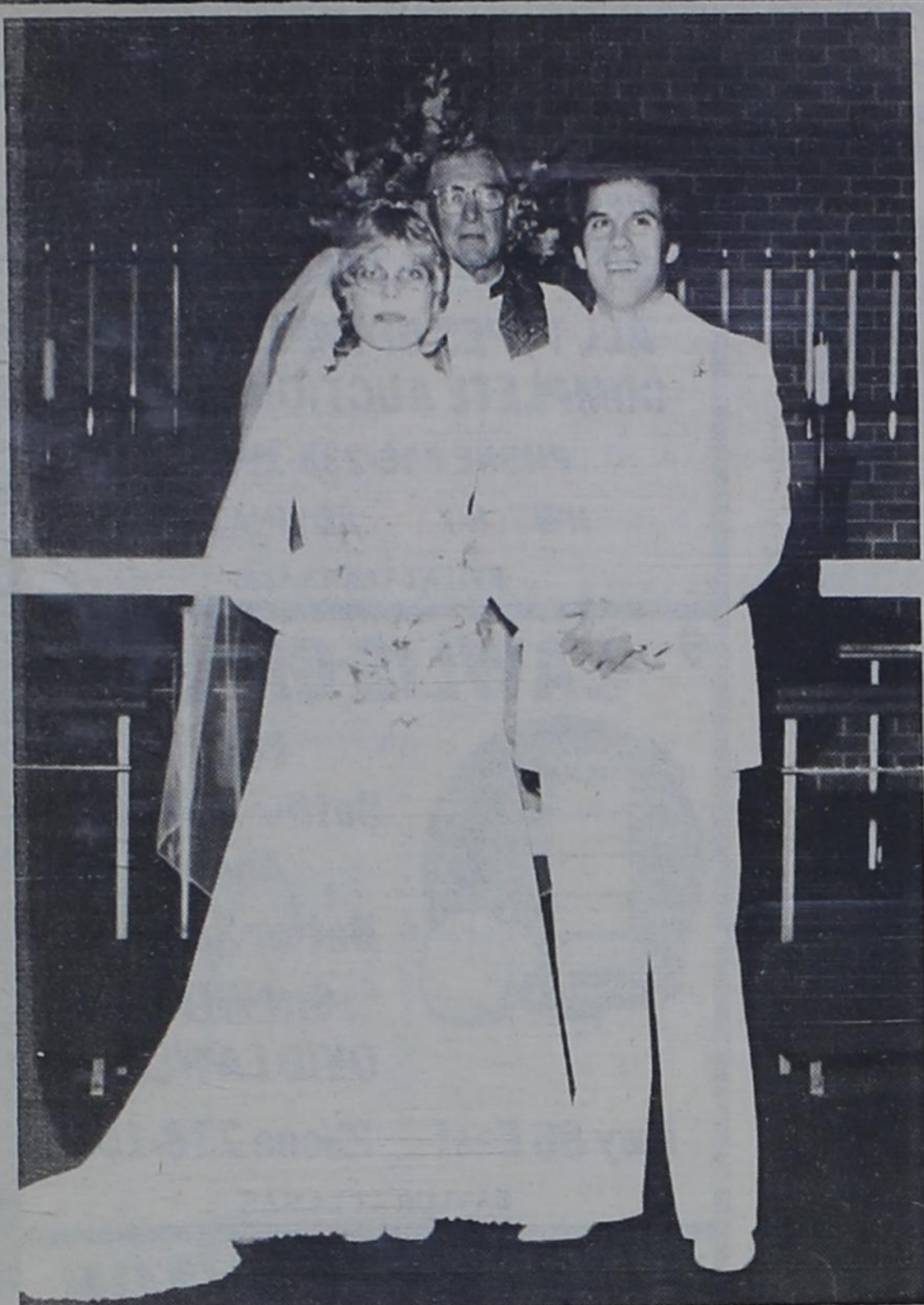

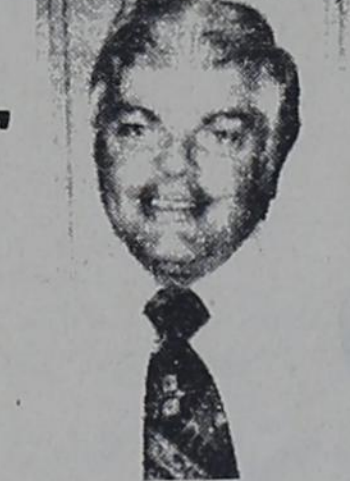

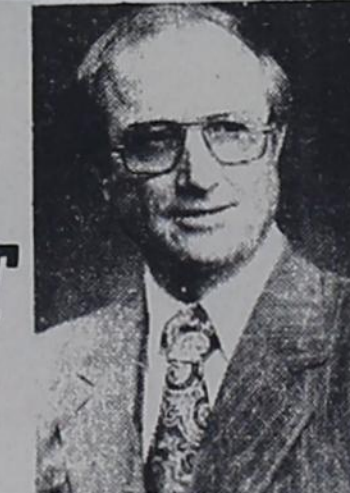
