Xerox Contract Dominates Monday's Called Commissioner's Court Meeting

The Mitchell County Commissioners met in a specially called session Monday to review items on a short agenda.

The commissioners discussed the Xerox contract currently held by the county and the offering to update the contract by Xerox representative, Yancy Spivey. The lease-purchase of copiers on the proposed contract would save the county approximately \$133 per month but the contract would also include a 12.5 percent finance charge.

These charges halted any action by the Court. They would like to look at other options for getting copies made without going by the "installment plan."

The commissioners also approved the renting of what is now the Family Planning building for the Juvenile Probation Officer. The Court stipulated that the rent on the facility would not exceed \$150

monthly. The renting of these offices is a temporary measure, according to the commissioners.

Sheriff Wendell Bryant was called away from his office and could not be reached for the details on the reserve deputy program so this item on the agenda was tabled.

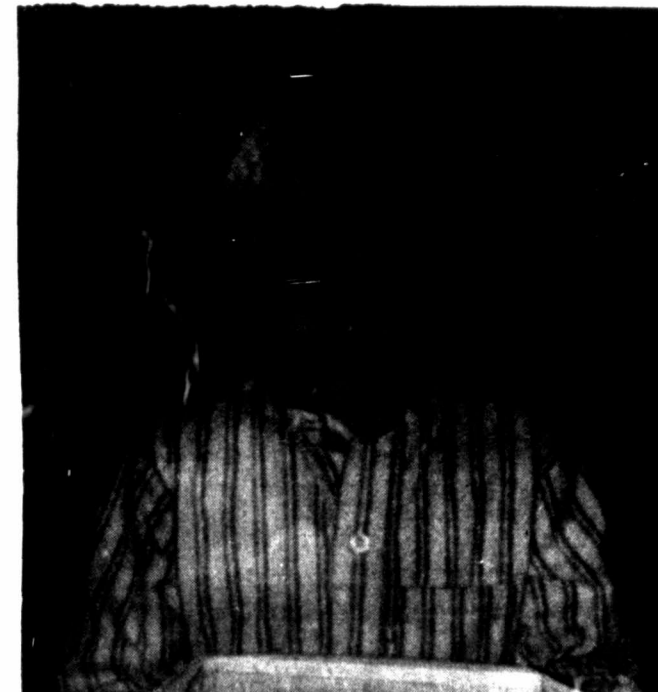
The Court reviewed a request by the Tax Office to rescind a motion made in the last session of the court to hire temporary part time help at the rate of \$4 per hour for a period of three months.

The employee wanted for the position in mind asked for \$4.17 and an increase was requested by the tax office to bring the candidate for employment up to that level.

The commissioners decided to raise the maximum pay for part time county employees to \$4.20. The pay rate would be at the discretion of the hiring supervisor.

89 Persons Expected To Perish

An estimated 89 persons will die on Texas streets and highways during the Christmas and New Year's holidays, according to the Texas Department of Public Safety statistics' office in Austin.

"The number of fatalities can be decreased if drivers will moderate their speed, refrain from using alcohol or drugs if driving and make sure everyone in the vehicle wears a seat belt," stated DPS Director Colonel Jim Adams.

The DPS estimates that 51 persons will die in motor vehicle accidents during the Christmas

holiday weekend and another 38 estimated to be killed during the New Year holiday weekend.

Sixty-four persons died in traffic crashes during the Christmas holiday period last year and 58 on the New Year's holiday, added Adams.

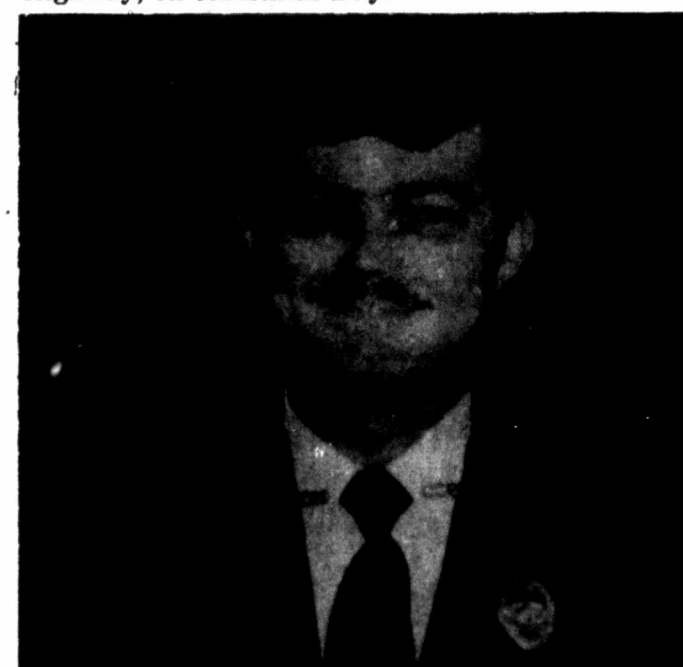
Adams stated that a head-on crash at only 30 mph hurls a person's body forward with the same force as a fall from a third story window, and seat belts could mean the difference between life and death.

"Make this a happy and safe Christmas for everyone—drive safe," concluded Adams.

City Receives Tax Rebate Of \$13,022

State Comptroller Bob Bullock sent checks totaling \$41.4 million to 802 cities as their share of the one-percent city sales tax for December.

This final payment for 1981 brought to \$656 million the total collected and returned to Texas cities during 1981. Bullock said this total is more than 17 percent over last year's \$560 million.

Colorado City's net payment this period was \$13,022.58 bringing the yearly total to \$193,747.92 as compared to \$163,428.82 last year.

Loraine's total for 1981 was \$5,372.57. This is \$361.85 less than last year's \$5,734.42 final total.

The optional one-percent city sales tax is collected along with the state four-percent sales tax by merchants and businesses and is rebated each month by the Comptroller to the cities where it is levied.

Thirteen Sealed Indictments Handed Down When Grand Jury Met Friday

The Mitchell County Grand Jury handed down 23 indictments Friday, with 13 of these being sealed indictments.

Antonio Gonzales was indicted on a second offense of driving while intoxicated (DWI) on November 22.

Eusebio (Sammy) Gonzales was also indicted on DWI charges violated on November 23.

Jamie Lewis Cagle of Sweetwater was indicted for knowingly possessing a useable quantity of marijuana.

John Franklin Rader of Colorado City was indicted for intentionally and knowingly delivering to Jamie Lewis Cagle, marijuana of more than one fourth an ounce on December 9.

Donna K. Ward was indicted for intentionally and knowingly appropriating property of a pair of western boots, valued at more than \$200 and less than \$10,000 on October 24.

Roberto Moreno was indicted on charges of intentionally, with the specific intent to commit the offense of murder, when he shot Ebaristo Barrera on November 27.

Johnny Lee Williams, Sam Williams, Sherry Williams and Henry David Williams, all of Colorado

City, were indicted on charges of knowingly possessing a useable quantity of marijuana of more than four ounces on December 6.

New Manager Will Begin January 11

The City Council of Colorado City met in special session Friday, December 18, for the purpose of interviewing Richard Crowley of Burleson for the position of City Manager. Crowley was offered the job Friday and accepted the position Monday according to Colorado City Mayor Elmer Martin.

Crowley attended Texas Tech University and Hardin-Simmons University after graduating from Hamlin High School. Richard Crowley is currently employed as Assistant to the City Manager for the City of Burleson.

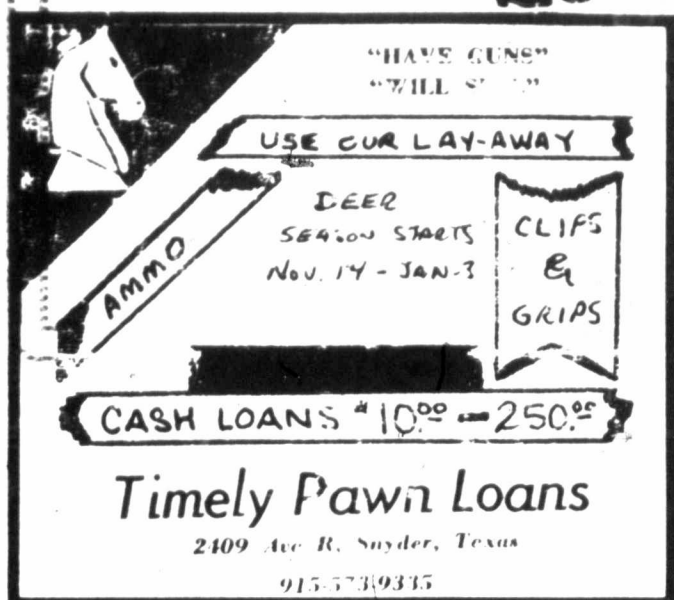

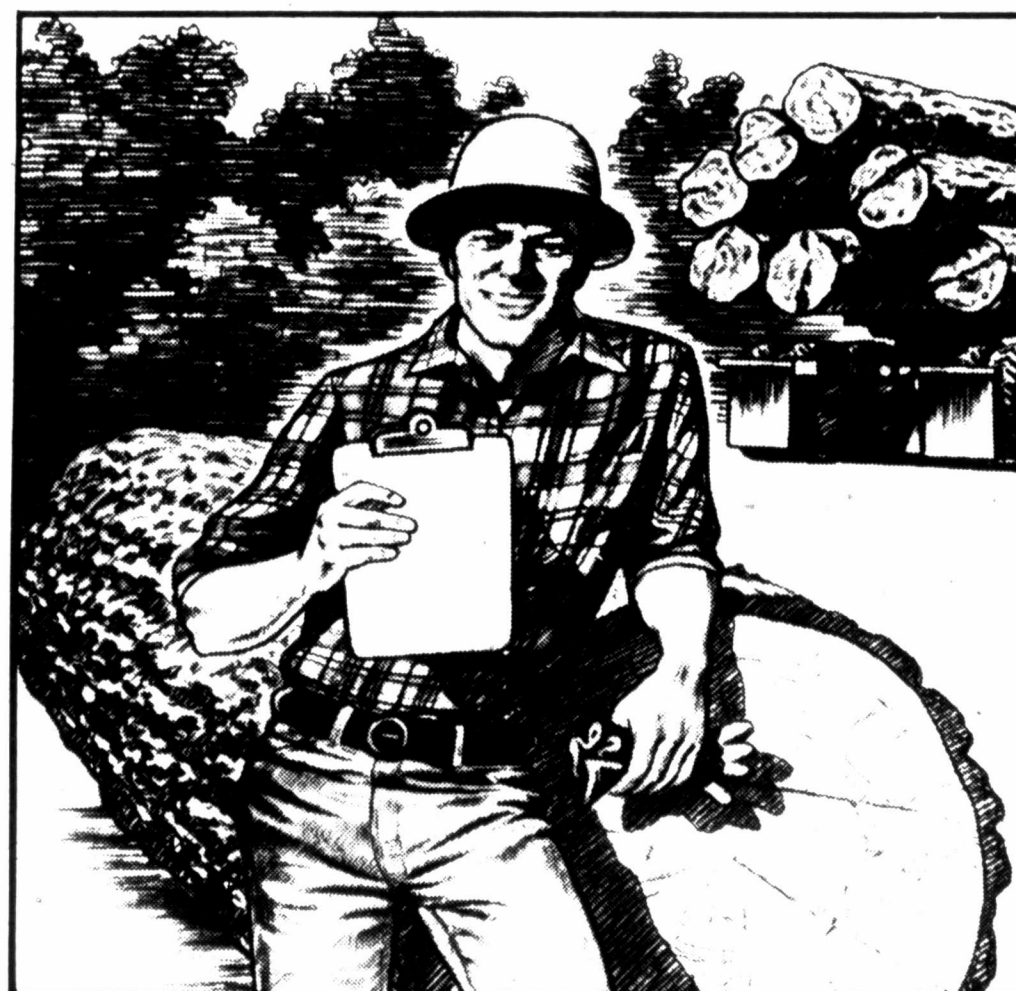

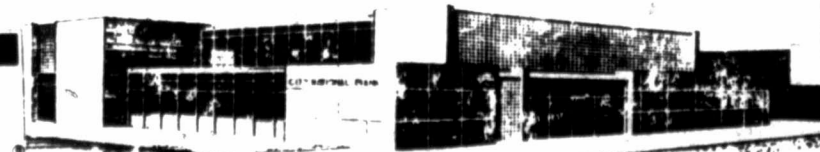
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
