

## BALE COUNT

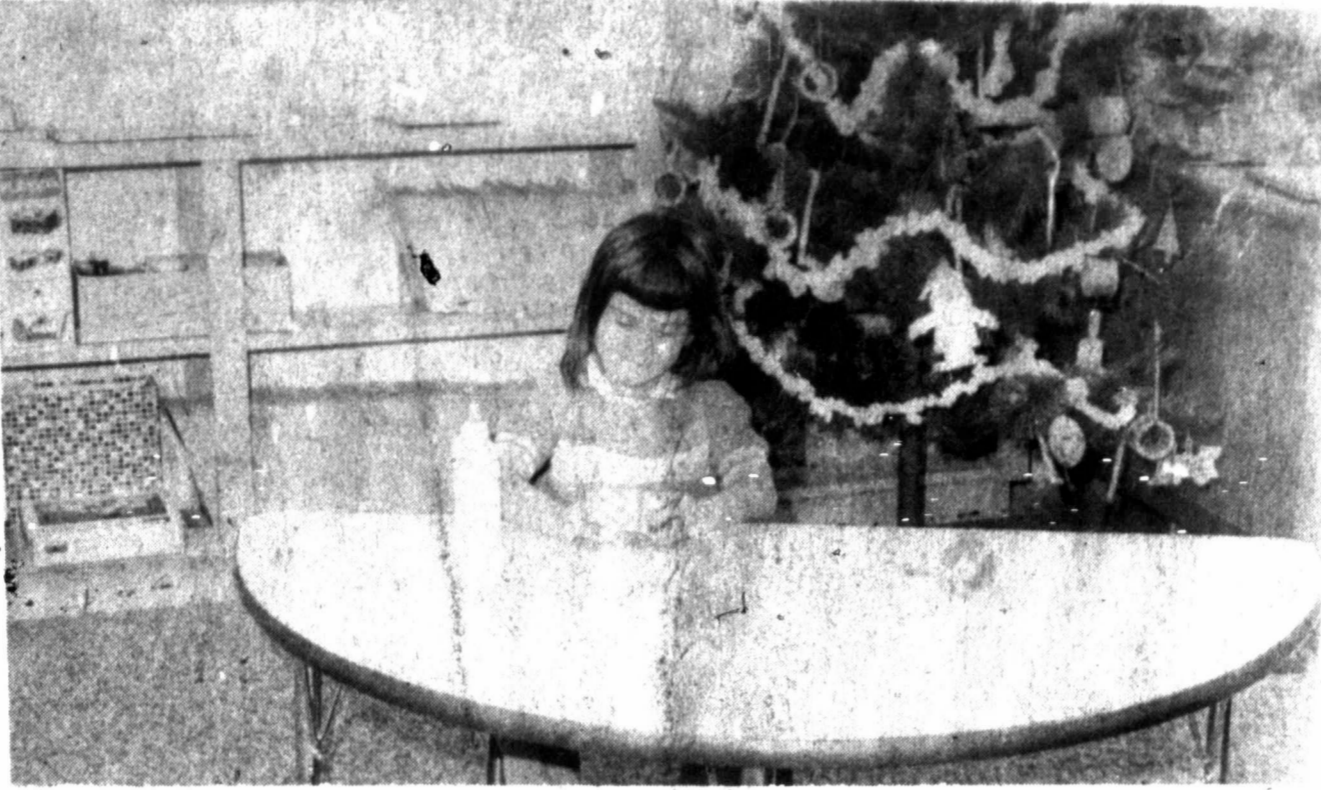

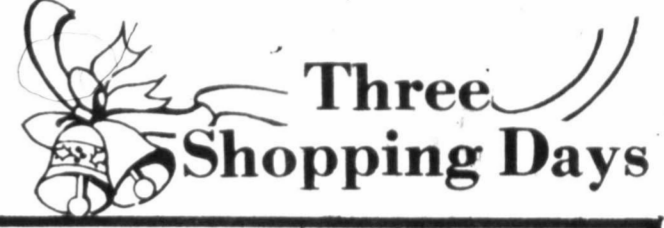

## Special Called Loraine City Council Meeting Is Moved Up To January 5

A closed hearing of the Loraine City Council that was slated for Tuesday, has been re-scheduled for Tuesday, January 5.

The hearing has been set to discuss the release of employment by the city of Brenda Lee, Loraine city secretary. Mrs. Lee was notified of the called hearing by the City Attorney Pete McKinney.

The council voted in their last meeting to release Mrs. Lee, but Mayor Vance Dickenson vetoed the vote. Council members Eddie Galvan, Jack Brewer and Calvin Forbus requested the closed hearing.

Mrs. Lee stated that she was requested of the city attorney that the meeting be opened to the public.

Reasons stated in the notification to Mrs. Lee were failure to keep the office open five days a week, failure to type a financial statement each month to be presented to the councilmen at each meeting, and the improper handling Mrs. Lee receiving an advance on her salary without proper authority.

In response to these accusations, Mrs. Lee stated that at the time her daughter was ill, she notified the council that she would need to take her daughter to

the doctor once a week. At that time, there was no problem, added Mrs. Lee, as she had a secretary who kept the office opened, but the council fired her later.

Mrs. Lee said, "as far as the financial statement, this was done by myself to help the councilmen to better understand the happenings of the previous month and this procedure was not mandatory."

In the final item on the notification, Mrs. Lee stated that the advance on her salary had occurred two years ago and the entire amount was paid in full. She added that the advance was approved by Mayor Dickenson.

Tuesday at 5 p.m., is the deadline set for the lighting contest sponsored by the Colorado City Chamber of Commerce which will be held Wednesday night.

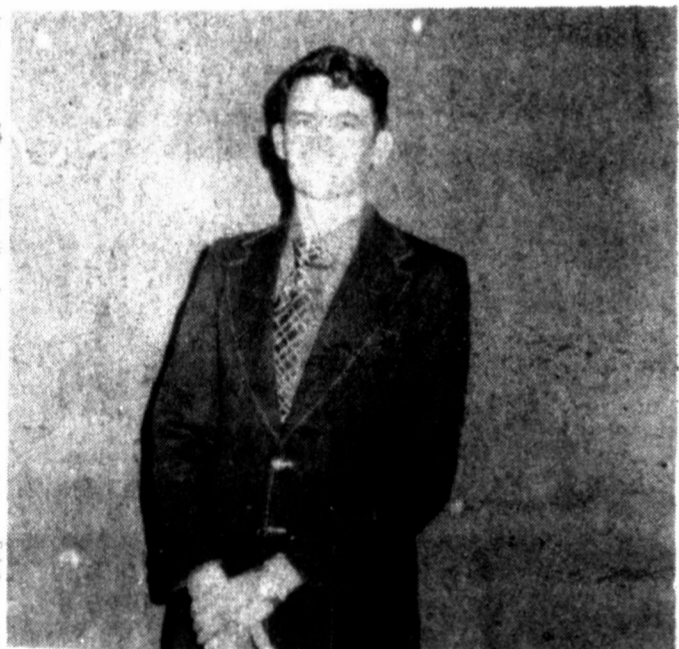
Persons wishing to enter may do so by phoning the Chamber at 728-3403.

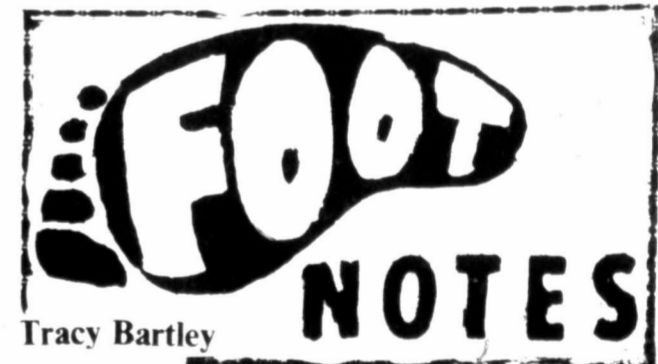
Roundtree stated the local woman agreed to assist the Colorado City Police Department and meet this person at the person's request.

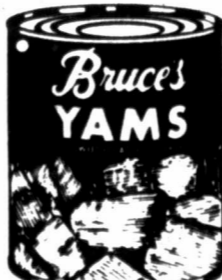

## CISD Board Approves Bid And New System

The Colorado Independent School District Board of Trustees met in regular session Tuesday night. Members of the board were guests of the CVAE class for a dinner at CMS (Colorado Middle School). Following the dinner, the group toured the new bus barn, recently built for the CISD. After the bus barn tour, they took another look at the new energy management system recently installed at CHS (Colorado High School).

The board met back at the administration office with the presentation of three teachers, followed by a presentation by Superintendent Charlie Uselton and Geneva Findley, administrative assistant, about problems arising from board policy statements on state and local sick leaves for teachers.

A recommendation by the administration was that they revise seven of the policies affecting the leaves of absences.

Shurtleff Company's bid of \$43,438.95 was approved by the board for the new bus barn shed. The Board also gave final approval for the energy management system from Oliver Energy Management Company in Lubbock for \$63,591.

Senate Bill 341 policies needing revision were approved and the driver education program was also approved by the board for the 1981-82 school year.

The Mitchell County Appraisal meeting with the Lovca Gathering Company was also discussed along with the revue of delinquent tax suits.

# Crude Oil Sales Rise High

The sale of crude oil and natural gas from Mitchell County wells in 1980 boosted the county economy and accounted for \$140.9-million of the \$31.2-billion value placed on Texas production last year.

In a report on the economic impact of oil and gas industry operations in the top producing counties of Texas, Dallas-based Texas Mid-Continent Oil & Gas Association said the county ranked 59th among Texas' 254 counties on the basis of the value of its marketed petroleum production. This includes condensate and casinghead gas.

The county's wells produced 6.2-million barrels of crude oil, valued at \$135-million, and 3.9-million Mcfs of natural gas, valued at \$5.9-million. Owners of royalty in the county received \$17.6-million as their share of the output, the Association said.

"Although crude oil and natural gas production in Texas declined slightly last year from 1979 levels, we in the industry are encouraged by the fact that drilling starts in 1980 were up 16-percent over the previous year," said the Association's chairman, Avery Ruah, Jr., of Amarillo. "Since petroleum remains the cornerstone

of our state's economy and its tax base, Texas must continue to encourage the development of its energy resources," Rush added.

In addition to paying local, county, and state property taxes, producers in the county also supported state government through production tax payments estimated at \$6.7-million,

according to the Association. Crude oil taxes amounted to \$6.2-million while natural gas levies totaled \$440,309.

Based on Texas Employment Commission figures, some 41 oil and gas industry employees in the county received wages of about \$345,388 in 1980.

In the search for new petroleum reserves in

the county, oil and gas operators spent a reported \$56.4-million in the drilling of 209 wells, including 14 wildcats, or exploratory wells. This effort resulted in the completion of 187 oil wells, although some \$10.8-million was lost in the drilling of 22 dry holes. As of March 1, 1981, there were 2,040 producing wells in the

county; 2,019 oil and 21 gas.



views to be broadcast by local radio and TV stations, and the distribution of informational pamphlets to the general public. A particularly interesting feature of the Campaign is the holding of a "Responsible Office Party" which actually demonstrates the do's and don'ts of hosting a party involving alcoholic beverages

to make sure no one unintentionally gets drunk. This year the "Responsible Office Party" was held on December 10 as a cooperative effort of the Lubbock Council on Alcoholism, Lubbock Regional MHRM Center, West Texas Savings and Loan, and Pinkie's Liquor Store. Many notable guests attended; had an enjoyable time; and no one left drunk.

## YOU AUTO KNOW

Q. How do I go about setting basic timing when the number of the sparkplug in the firing order is inaccessible?

A. This sometimes happens due to placement of air conditioning compressors, pollution control devices and other engine-mounted devices. In this case, use the companion cylinder method of timing. The companion to the number 1 cylinder can be determined by the engine's firing order. In a four cylinder engine, the companion cylinder is the third in the firing order; in six cylinder engines it's the fourth in firing order, and in eight cylinder engines, the companion cylinder is fifth in the firing order. Firing order is found either on the engine's intake manifold, stamped into the metal, or in your car's service manual.

# Christmas Around The World

Christmas is celebrated in many parts of the world and in many different ways.

The word Christmas is actually a combination of two words: Cristes Maesse, or the mass of Christ, meaning a celebration of the birth of Christ.

Christmas in America—these words evoke different remembrances to each of us as varied as America itself.

Wherever you go in the United States, you will find customs that have been brought to the New World from the Old...plus, customs from the New World have contributed in turn.

Each tradition tells us something about the history of that particular area and together, the history of the country itself, as told through our varied celebrations of Christmas.

Whether children are raised in the city or the country of America, they find a richness of holiday traditions to draw upon.

For those living in New York City, for instance, Christmas means lighting the great tree at Rockefeller Center, and dazzling productions of the classic ballet, "The Nutcracker." Ice skating at Rockefeller Center is another well-loved holiday pastime for children in the city.

On the other coast, Los Angeles has its own traditions of the season. The annual "Hollywood Christmas Parade of Stars," featuring Santa and celebrities, and the spectacular parade of illuminated boats along Los Angeles Harbor are among the many holiday attractions.

In a Wisconsin town, the usual holiday celebration consists of the lighting of the community tree, followed by a parade with Santa as its main attraction.

But in a town in Louisiana, the season is celebrated with fireworks. As you might expect, the town of Bethlehem in Pennsylvania, puts on a spectacular display of colored lights during the Christmas season. The Pennsylvania Dutch, on the other hand, are noted for their beautiful nativity scenes, featuring carved figures and detailed landscaping.

Santa Fe residents pay tribute to the city's Spanish and Mexican heritage by enacting "Las Posadas," the story of Mary and Joseph's search for posada, or lodging. Also, part of the many New Mexican Christmas observations are special Indian rituals, such as the animal dances, along with luminous decorations throughout the home, accented with festive candle lights of Spanish and Mexican tradition.

Children living in rural areas of midwestern and northern states may still enjoy an old-fashioned Christmas complete with sleigh-rides and snowmen, but youngsters in such warm climate states as Hawaii and Florida have an altogether different Ule experience. In Hawaii, greetings of the season are more than likely to consist of floral leis, bestowed with a kiss on the cheek and "Aloha" and in Florida, palm trees are decorated for the holidays.

In Austria, a charming candle ceremony reminds us that Christ is the light of the world. According to this custom, families gather together on Christmas Eve, before three large wax candles. The first candle is lit, as the words, "Christ is Born," are chanted. On Christmas Day, the second candle is lit and the third candle is lit on New Year's Day.

Mexican youngsters celebrate Christmas the same way they celebrate birthdays—with a pinata. The pinata is a clay vessel, decorated with paper to resemble an animal and filled with all kinds of goodies. Each youngster is blindfolded and given a stick with which to swing at the pinata. When it is broken, the children scramble for the contents.

A colorful parade marks Christmas in the Philippine Islands. There the children wear wreaths and chains made of flowers as they parade, singing holiday songs. A religious service precedes this Christmas parade, which is followed by family dinners.

Greenlanders can always look forward to a white Christmas, but because of Greenland's climate, their Christmas trees have to be imported. Those who do not attend church services burn candles in their windows to light the way for the church-goers. Candles are also used on the Christmas tree, which may be hung with small baskets, filled with sweets.

Christmas in Brazil is very similar to Christmas in the United States, except for the noise. There the custom is to sound factory sirens at midnight on Christmas Eve. Families usually attend midnight mass, after which they enjoy a feast of turkey or lamb and either visit at home or go out. Gifts are exchanged and champagne toasts of "Feliz Natal" are made to give to family and friends.

In Greece, Christmas is also observed with family get-togethers, along with a rather quaint custom. Old leather shoes are burned during the holiday season, to drive away the karkantzari, mysterious creatures who like to do mischief at this time. A priest may even be called upon to perform special rites with a cross entwined with basil sprigs and dipped into holy water to chase away the karkantzari.

Portuguese children place their shoes around the fireplace for Santa to fill on Christmas Eve. At midnight, family members gather for a big turkey dinner and other holiday foods that have been baked beforehand. Christmas trees are decorated for holidays and greeting cards are exchanged.

In Italy, children eagerly await gifts from the Italian version of Santa Claus, known as Father Christmas. Attending church services at Christmas time is the custom among Italian families, as is the exchanging of pauletone, a special holiday cake.

To the New Englander, Christmas can mean Santa coming to town on a hay wagon.

Christmas in Denmark is a festive occasion as any Dane will tell you. Typical of the spirit of the season is the Danish julenisse, a jolly, little elf with a white beard, dressed in bright red garb. Danish children set a bowl of rice porridge for him on Christmas Eve, to make sure the julenisse, or Christmas elf, doesn't do any mischief about the house.

Another tradition in the Danish home is the Christmas tree decorated with tiny heart shaped baskets of woven colorful paper, filled with candy treats. No Danish Christmas is complete without the festive dish of Christmas stuffed goose with apples and prunes along with the traditional drink, akavit. Their Christmas is brought to a highlight with the midnight service on Christmas Eve. Their tradition Danish greeting at Christmastime is "Glaedeelig Jul."

Although Christmas is celebrated in different ways throughout the world, the same good spirit and goodwill and joy is found everywhere.

All would not be complete without the Christmas music.

The holiday music tradition began on the night the angels sang for the awesome shepherds and since then, simple carols and great oratoricals alike have expressed humanity's joy and wonder of the events of Christmas.

Wherever and however Christmas is celebrated, it is observed with the spirit of joy, like the great "birthday party" that it is.

## TREMENDOUS TRIFLES

THE WAGER THAT STARTED THE MOVIES

None could have foreseen the connection between a WAGER and the MOTION PICTURE industry. Seems like a trivial thing? That's just the point! SO MANY IMPORTANT THINGS HAVE STARTED IN SUCH INCONSIDERABLE WAYS!

Two famous sportsmen of the day fell upon a discussion of a sport they both loved: horse-racing. One of these was Leland Stanford (for whom the famed university is today named) and the other was a noted sportsman of the day. The point of the discussion seemed to be whether all four legs of a horse left the ground at the same time during a run, a gallop or canter. You must remember that this was before the days of advanced photography and it was difficult to prove what today seems simple, indeed! Feeling became keener as the sportsmen differed, irreconcilably, on this point. It ended in a wager of some five thousand dollars. And then it was necessary to devise ways and means of complete proof.

It was finally determined to utilize the talents of a noted photographer of the day, Edward Muybridge of New York, and the solution of the problem was placed entirely with him.

Muybridge ingeniously devised a battery of sixteen cameras, placed within a foot of each other along the course to be traversed by a champion race horse of the day. To each of these cameras shutters a string was attached that would be tripped by the horse's legs as he ran, galloped, cantered across the prescribed course. In this way, he would be photographed in sixteen different positions. Now, the story ends in two ways: it definitely established the fact that all four legs of a horse DO leave the ground, thereby earning the wagered sum for his sponsor. But far more important was the incidental and accidental result...

Thomas A. Edison was the most important inventor of the day. His interests had led him into many and varied fields. But it was never in the direction of photography.

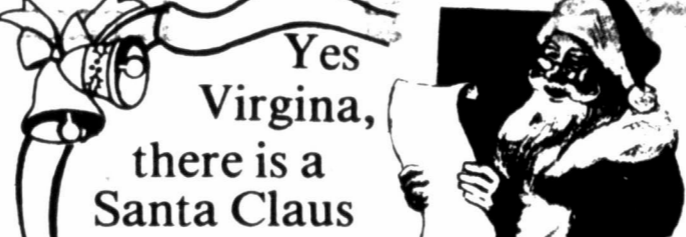
One day Edison chanced upon the series of pictures that had been prepared by Muybridge in settlement of the wager in a flash, he saw in it the central idea of continuous motion: if these intervals between the movements could be made shorter, there would be a more realistic effect of continuous motion.

That was all that was necessary for the fertile and inventive mind of the Wizard of Menlo Park. It was the beginning of a long series of experiments in the field of continuous motion. It was the beginning of Edison's interest in the pioneer motion pictures with which his name is imperishably linked.

In this great universe of ours man is a mere insect, an ant, in his intellect, as compared with the boundless world about him, as measured by the intelligence capable of grasping the whole of truth and knowledge.

Yes, Virginia, there is a Santa Claus. He exists as certainly as love and generosity and devotion exist, and you know that they abound and give to your life its highest beauty and joy. Alas! How dreary would be the world if there were no Santa Claus. It would be as dreary as if there were no Virginias. There would be no childlike faith then, no poetry, no romance to make tolerable this existence. We should have no enjoyment, except in sense and sight. The eternal light with which childhood fills the world would be extinguished.

Not believe in Santa Claus? You might as well not believe in fairies. You might get your papa to hire men to watch in all the chimneys on Christmas Eve to catch Santa Claus, but even if they did not see Santa Claus coming down, what would that prove? Nobody sees Santa Claus, but that is no sign that there is no Santa Claus.
